Step 1: Pick your own theme or create your own

Step 2: Create a title

On your outline page, come up with possible titles for your book.

Step 3: Brainstorming

On your outline page, brainstorm a beginning, middle, and end. These ideas do not have to be full sentences, just an idea.

Step 4: Building Character

On your outline page, list the name and a detail about each character you want to include in your book. i.e. Godzilla: my pet chihuahua who thinks he is the biggest dog on the block

Step 5: Pre-writing

On a scratch piece of paper, write down your story in full. Then, have a grown-up read the story. Ask them to make any corrections to spelling and/or punctuation. Finally, ask them to give any suggestions.

Step 6: Re-writing

Write down your story using the pages provided either on Ms. Dixon's website, or printed by the school. Make sure to be neat. Write in your nicest handwriting.

Step 7: Illustrating

First, illustrate the cover of your book. Then, illustrate each page using any materials available - pencil, crayons, markers, colored pencils, paint, etc. (If you have any questions about this, contact Ms. Dixon)
