The school will offer several opportunities for the parents to take an active role in the student's education by offering a forum for collaboration with staff members, activities that will aid in the education of the students, and provide timely information about Title I programs through meetings, letters, or phone communications.

The following are the primary features of a plan that will incorporate strategies for parental involvement that will contribute to shared responsibilities for increased student academic achievement. Strategies that will be utilized to promote the plan:

- 1) A parent involvement meeting will take place in the beginning of the school year to inform parents regarding the school's involvement in Title I. During the meeting the school will distribute and/or review:
  - The School-Parent Student Compact
  - Title I funding budget information / spending items
  - Opportunities to communicate with the teachers and administration to improve the academic Performance of their child.
- 2) Numerous opportunities will be provided throughout the school year to strengthen the building ties between parent and school, to include:
  - Parent volunteers will serve on the Title I committee throughout the year to advise on all Title I parent involvement matters.
  - Suggestions from the teacher for activities/materials for parents to involve their students at home in their educational development.

- The importance of student attendance and resulting academic performance will be discussed throughout the year. Students with perfect attendance will be recognized and given an award.
  - Parent/Teacher meetings will be encouraged and times made available to meet the needs of the parents. This will include teacher availability thirty minutes prior to school, during the teacher's planning time, or thirty minutes after the end of the school day. Teachers will need a one day notice for meetings.
  - Parents are invited to attend their child's classroom each year for day/night class learning/activities as scheduled at various dates throughout the year.
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- 3) As a school wide Title 1 school, a survey will be distributed at the end of the year to all parents. The feedback will allow the school to evaluate the Title 1 program and from the results make changes to improve the Title 1 services being offered.

This plan will be updated on an annual basis to reflect the dynamic needs of the parents and school.
