Mathematics: Mrs. Pinkerton and Mrs. Coleman

We will work on this critical area of focus:

Solve multiple step word problems posed with whole numbers having whole number answers using the four operations. Find factor pairs for a whole number 1-100. Recognize that a whole number is a multiple of each of its factors. Determine whether a given number in the range of 1-100 is prime or composite. (Standards 4.OA.1, 4.OA.2, 4.OA.3, 4.OA.4, 4.NBT.5, 4.NBT.6)

We will begin reviewing for the Ohio AIR test, and helping students practice skills they need to succeed on it.
