### Hello Parents.

After our third day of school, there are some items that I would like to remind everyone of:

### Communication

- <u>Teachers are not expected to return emails during morning instruction time.</u> This time is dedicated to teaching students both in-person & remotely.
- If distance learners are having issues connecting, they can reach out to the teachers who will have more time to return emails in the afternoon.

# Distance Learning

- A parent should not be talking to or asking teachers questions during a remote lesson. If there is an issue, have the student and/or parent reach out to the teachers during the afternoon hours.
- We are still working on getting all of the technology pieces in place. Please be patient with our teachers during this time. Everyone wants to get everything working as soon as possible.

## Specials

• We are still working on the most efficient way for specials teachers (PE, Music, Library, Art, Computers, etc.) to connect with students during this hybrid teaching model.

#### Arrival

- At arrival time, it is <u>not ok to drop your child off in the middle of Penfield</u>.
- Please pull over safely and drop them off in the gravel area, if you will not be pulling into the car rider line.

### Dismissal:

- Students are <u>not allowed to walk to the high school parking lot or one of the other side</u>
  <u>streets to get into a vehicle</u>. This causes an unsafe situation. Many times, students are then
  crossing the road to get into their parent's vehicles.
- Also, you may not block the high school driveway entrance.
- There are no parking signs that have been placed around both BES and BHS drives. Please respect those signs, they are there to allow drivers to safely see into the street they are turning in.
- Students are only allowed to enter cars along the cones. If they are walking down the hill of grass to enter your car, they will be directed to wait until the vehicle is pulled up into an area marked with cones.
