Just a few reminders

For our car riders in the morning: Now that the cool weather is approaching, we are getting several temperatures that are reading above the initial threshold of 99 degrees F. Upon arriving at school, please lower the heat in the car and make certain your child doesn't have a hood up over his or her head. When a child's temp consistently reads above this first threshold, we require Nurse Jayde to do a quick evaluation and temperature check. This could slow your morning down, as you will have to pull over and wait. Thank you for your cooperation with this concern.

Another reminder for morning car riders: Please have your child here and in the building before 7:46 a.m. The instructional day begins at this time, so students need to be in the room ready to begin their day. Thank you, as well, for your help with this concern.
