



Harney County Schools Season #2 Event Management Plan

The following plan applies to events hosted by Burns High School (BHS) and Hines Middle School (HMS) based on a *moderate* county risk level. Should there be changes in our county risk level during the course of season #2, these protocols may change accordingly.

Masks will be worn at all indoor and outdoor events. If an individual refuses to wear a mask, they will be asked to leave the facility. *If they refuse to leave, the competition will be cancelled.*

Maximum Indoor Capacity: 100 people Maximum Outdoor Capacity: 150 people

All home Middle and High School football contests will be live streamed on the district's facebook page.

- <u>BHS will not be charging a gate fee.</u> <u>Donations will be accepted.</u> All guests are still required to check in at the main ticket booth entry. The back gate will NOT be open.
- BHS and HMS students will each be allowed to invite 2 guests.
- Guests may only stay for the event in which they were invited to. We will need to clear the gym before each new HMS game. BHS games will not require a gym clear
- BHS and HMS HOME spectators will be expected to check in at the front ticket booth prior to entrance to the field. If your name is not on the list or you do not have the proper ticket you will not be allowed to enter.
- HOME spectators will be expected to maintain social distancing at all times.
- 1. Facility Protocols/Game Management
 - Coaches, players, officials and spectators are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when indoors and outdoors.
 - All staff members, players, coaches, officials, and other volunteers will be screened prior to each event.
 - Names and contact information of all participants, coaches, officials, spectators, etc. will be recorded for contact tracing purposes.

- Visiting team will provide <u>documentation</u> that all players, coaches, drivers, and other support staff have been screened prior to arriving on campus.
- Game officials will use designated officials room for their dressing and meeting area before, during and after the contest.
- Visiting football team will use the girls locker room. 10 individuals allowed in the locker room at one time. Coaches are responsible for locker room monitoring.
- Crows nest will be available for Home and Away staff only.
- Porta-Potties are available on both the East and West side of the football field. Indoor restrooms will not be available.
- Footballs will be sanitized as appropriate between each exchange.
- Outdoor concession stands will NOT be open.

VOLLEYBALL

Organization of Home Contests

Middle School, F/S, JV and Varsity contests will each be run as separate events. At the conclusion of each game, the gym will be cleared and sanitized prior to the next contest starting.

The visiting teams athletes and coaches will ALL be allowed into the gym from the start to the event and not required to clear in between

- 3) Ticket Takers: 2
- 4) Clock operator: 1
- 5) Bookkeeper: 2 (home book & libero tracker only at scorers table)
- 6) Officials: 2

- 8) Administration: 2

- BHS and HMS students will each be allowed to invite 2 guests.
- Guests may only stay for the event in which they were invited to. We will need to clear the gym before each new HMS game. BHS games will not require a gym clear

1. Facility Protocols/Game Management

- Coaches, players, officials and spectators are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when indoors and outdoors.
- All staff members, players, coaches, officials, and other volunteers will be screened prior to each event.
- Names and contact information of all participants, coaches, officials, spectators, etc. will be recorded for contact tracing purposes.
- Visiting team will provide <u>documentation</u> that all players, coaches, drivers, and other support staff have been screened prior to arriving on campus.
- Visiting MS volleyball teams will need to be dressed and ready upon arrival.
- Visiting HS volleyball teams will use the boys HS locker room when available.
- 10 individuals allowed in locker rooms at one time. Coaches are responsible for monitoring locker room use.
- Designated team bench areas will be roped off to provide for proper social distancing. Spectators will not be allowed in these areas.
- Teams will not switch benches or sides of court between sets
- Table crew will be limited to essential personnel: home team clock operator, scorebook keeper, and libero tracker.
- Volleyballs will be sanitized using a three ball rotation when appropriate.
- During sanitation between games, teams will return to locker rooms or cafeteria. All other spectators will leave the building until doors open back up.
- Indoor concessions will NOT be open.

- 2. Facility Protocols/Game Management
 - Coaches, players, officials and spectators are required to wear a mask or face covering at all times when indoors and outdoors.
 - All staff members, players, coaches, officials, and other volunteers will be screened prior to each event.
 - Names and contact information of all participants, coaches, officials, spectators, etc. will be recorded for contact tracing purposes.
 - Visiting team will provide <u>documentation</u> that all players, coaches, drivers, and other support staff have been screened prior to arriving on campus.
 - Visiting MS and HS teams will need to be dressed and ready upon arrival.
 - Designated team areas will be clearly identified to provide for proper social distancing. Spectators will not be allowed in these areas.
 - The course route will be identified ahead of time and all spectators may find a location on the route to watch.
 - Spectators must maintain social distancing and mask requirements.
 - Spectators will not be allowed near the start or finish line.
