OBTAINING AN EDUCATOR LICENSE WITH STIPULATIONS - PARAPROFESSIONAL

A paraprofessional educator endorsement (sometimes known as a Teacher's Aide) on an educator license with stipulations may be issued to an individual who is at least 19 years of age, holds a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent, and has met one of the following requirements*:

1. Has completed at least 60 semester hours of credit from a regionally accredited institution of higher education (excluding remedial coursework and coursework must be a grade C or higher)
2. Holds an associate degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution of higher education

Step 1: Create an Educator Licensure Information System (ELIS) account. Visit <https://www.isbe.net/> and click "System Quick Links" at the top of the page. Click on "ELIS: Educator Licensure Information System," then choose "Login to your ELIS account" in the middle left of the page. Follow the steps to set up your ELIS account.

Step 2: Submit an application in ELIS. There will be an Action Center in the middle of your ELIS homepage. Underneath, there will be a link that says "Apply for a Paraprofessional License (Teacher's Aide)." An application fee (plus a processing fee) will be assessed electronically when the application is submitted. You will need a debit/credit card to complete this step.

Step 3: Request official college transcript(s) be sent to the Regional Office of Education. NOTE: Make every effort to have them sent electronically to Brittany Stegall at bstegall@roe33.net as that will expedite the process of obtaining a license. NOTE: If you have recently graduated, you will want to be sure when ordering that you select to wait to send until your degree line has been added to the transcript.

Step 4: Register your issued license in ELIS. A registration fee will be assessed electronically when the registration is completed. You will need a debit/credit card to complete this step. You will register your license in ROE #33, Henderson/Knox/Mercer/Warren Counties via your ELIS account. Once registered, the license is valid until June 30 immediately following five years of the endorsement being issued and may be renewed.

*****If you do not meet the college coursework requirements, you will be able to take an exam once legislation is passed later this year.**

There is state legislation in the works to institute an exam that individuals will be able to take in order to gain their paraprofessional endorsement without college coursework.
