

11th Grade Need to Know Checklist....

- Please visit www.ACT.org to sign up to take the ACT Test.
 - ACT Academy – Free test prep (www.academy.act.org)
 - School Code: 372-940
 - If you qualify for Free & Reduced Lunches, you can receive two (2) ACT fee waivers.
 - See Ms Baker for the waiver.
- Visit www.okcollegestart.org to create an account and start your profile. There are approximately 20,000 scholarships to apply for.
 - There is a FREE ACT test prep on this website.
- State Testing Required:**
 - ACT (Free for Students) Test in April
 - Science: Online in April
 - US History: Online in April
- Concurrent Enrollment**
 - In April/May request a transcript and concurrent form, which must be signed by Ms Baker or Principal Smith.
 - Student must meet requirements to enroll. (See Ms Baker for more details.)
 - Student must enroll in 6 concurrent hours and 4 hours at the high school.
 - Tuition is waived for 18 Credit Hours during Senior Year. (subject to change)
 - Summer between junior and senior year counts as a tuition fee waived.
- Awards:** Students can apply for the Vision Bank's Junior of the Year Award
 - Applications will be in Ms Baker's Office

- **Bank Boards:** Students can apply to be on the Vision Bank Board and BancFirst Bank Board in January.
 - Applications will be in Ms Baker's Office
- **Boys State and Girls State**
 - Application are in Ms Baker's Office and the Deadline is December.
 - Boys and Girls State takes place in the summer between junior and senior year.
- **Juniors are in charge of Prom.** Juniors will have a JR Class Sponsor and will have two (2) fundraisers to help with the cost of Prom. If Juniors choose not to do fundraiser then they will be asked to pay for their Prom Ticket. (See JR Class Sponsor for more details.)
 - The approximate cost \$100.
- All Prague students that are Native American that have a CDIB card, check with Sac 'n Fox for items they may reimburse for; example: Class rings, Letterman Jackets, Announcements, Cap and Gowns, etc.
- **NCAA/NAIA:** Make sure all NCAA/NAIA are being met and you are signed up online at www.NCAA.org
 - Cost: \$80 (There is a fee waiver available, see website for more details)
