



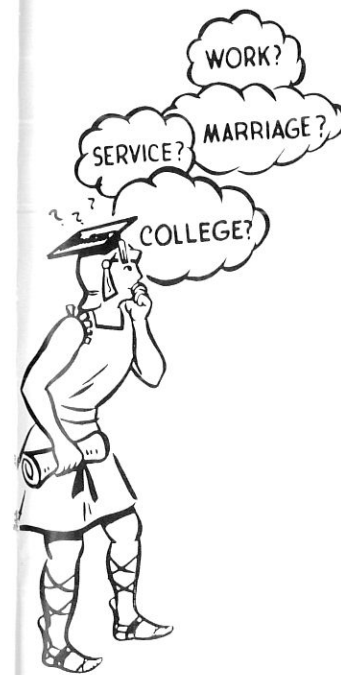

Lastly, Mrs. Pat Hughes, for the free day she gave us on December 20, 1985.

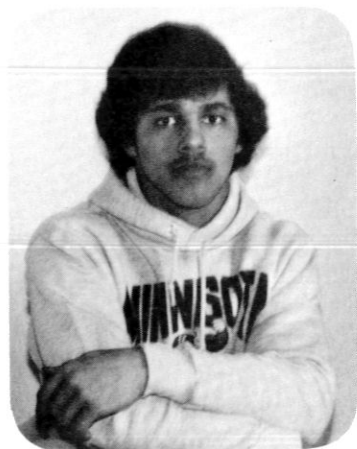
