SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

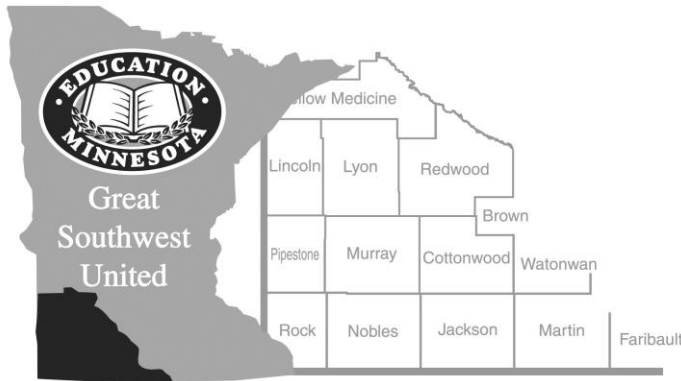
- Five \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded
 - Four (4) scholarships for graduating seniors
 - One (1) scholarship to be awarded to a college student entering into their collegiate year prior to their student teaching experience.
- Scholarships will be awarded after completion of one semester of post-secondary enrollment
 - Must achieve a minimum of 2.5 GPA
 - Must show proof of enrollment for second semester

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Must be son, daughter, or under the guardianship of a current GSU member
- Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- Must have been accepted to a post-secondary institution

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- Completed applications must be post-marked no later than **March 19, 2021.**
- Completed applications will include
 - Personal Background
 - Personal Statement
 - Transcript from high school or college
 - Recommendation by any GSU member (high school seniors only)
