Job Title: <u>CROSSING GUARD</u>

Reports To: School Principal

Work Year: 171 – 175 days

Work Day: 1-2 hours

Job Goal: Under supervision of the site principal, to monitor and to provide a safe traffic flow and crossing for each student to and from school each day in accordance with the rules and policies of the district.

Essential Requirements: To perform this job successfully an individual must be able to execute each requirement satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skills and/or ability needed for the position:

- 1. Knowledge of activities and interests of children
- 2. Ability to exercise tact, patience, kindness and positive attitude.
- 3. Ability to remain energetic and enthusiastic about children.
- 4. Ability to be reliable in attendance and execution of duties.
- 5. Ability to establish and maintain friendly, cooperative and effective working relationships with all persons contacted in the course of work.
- 6. Ability to Establish and maintain friendly, cooperative and effective relationships with students.
- 7. Ability to work harmoniously with others and to communicate effectively (both orally and in writing) with students and staff;
- 8. Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions;
- 9. Ability to maintain confidentiality of students and their records;
- 10. Ability to work effectively in an environment which can be both physically and emotionally fatiguing; perform physically demanding requirements of the job;
- 11. Ability to demonstrate standards of moral character and behavior to serve as an effective role model for students;
- 12. Ability to demonstrate a positive attitude in working with children with special needs
- 13. Ability to direct and respond appropriately to students:
- 14. Ability to perform physical activities which may include frequent standing, walking, bending, and/or lifting;
- 15. Such alternative to the above requirements as the School Board or the Administration may deem appropriate and acceptable.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: Duties may include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Be aware of and implement all crossing rules and regulations.
- 2. Supervise and monitor students during assigned supervision periods.
- 3. Be aware of and enforce school safety standards at all times.
- 4. Report any unsafe conditions, including equipment, to the site principal immediately.
- 5. Act as a friendly ambassador for the Stark County School District;
- 6. Perform such other tasks as may seem to be appropriate to the Board or Administration;

- 7. Participate in in-service programs as assigned;
- 8. Maintains satisfactory attendance, as defined in District policy and regulations

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS, BONDING, AND/OR TESTING REQUIRED:

- 1. Criminal Justice Fingerprint Clearance; and
- 2. Blood borne Pathogen Training/Hepatitis B Shot Series/Training as designated by the District.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Must maintain the ability to perform the essential functions of this job.

- 1. Ability to communicate so others will be able to clearly understand a normal conversation
- 2. Ability to routinely lift/carry supplies and materials weighing up to 25 pounds.
- 3. Ability to work in anoutdoor work environment subject to varying weather conditions
- 4. Ability to work in condition requiring bending, to assist students; standing for prolonged period of time; and reaching in all directions.
