



## LHS Athletic Attendance Policy

2020-2021

Effective Until 9.30.2020

Pursuant to Governor Tate Reeves' executive order 1522 to include orders 1492, 1496, 1500, 1505, 1508, 1511, 1514, 1516, 1518, and 1519, 1520, attendance to all athletic events will "be limited to a maximum of 25% of the venue's seating capacity (excluding coaches, directors, teachers, referees/officials, medical personnel, staff/workers, and press/media) depending on the space available to ensure a minimum of six feet social distancing between persons not in the same household."

Events that this applies to:

- 9/14 – 9<sup>th</sup>/JV Football vs. SHS (Home)
- 9/18 – Football vs. Tishomingo County (Homecoming)
- 9/24 - Volleyball vs. Collierville (Home)
- 9/25 – Football vs. HLHS (Home)
- 9/28 – Volleyball vs. Hernando High (Home)

### **Volleyball Ticket Procedure**

- Tickets will be available for sale at the ticket booth in the gym lobby.
- Precedence will be given to the families of student participants (Up to 4 per participant)
- Ticket booth will open 30 minutes prior to the game.

### **Football Ticket Procedure**

- LHS student participants will be allowed to purchase up to four (4) tickets each.
- Any available tickets after pre-sale will be sold at the ticket booth the night of the event.
- Ticket booth will open 1 hour prior to the game.

## **LHS Safety Precautions**

- **Indoor Events**
  - All attendees will be required to wear a mask during the event including when in transit to or from their seat (including at the ticket gate, in concourses, etc.), in restrooms, in concession sales areas and in seating areas.
  - Hand sanitizer stations will be available at entry points, restrooms, in the bleachers, and at the concession stands.
- **Outdoor Events**
  - All attendees will be expected to wear a face covering, covering the nose and mouth while attending an *outdoor* event when in transit to or from their seat (including at the ticket gate, at the concession stands, etc.), in restrooms, in concession sales areas, and at all other times when it is not possible to maintain a minimum of six (6) feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household. (Note: wearing a face covering is strongly encouraged even when social distancing is possible.)
  - Hand sanitizer stations will be available at entry points, restrooms, in the bleachers, and at the concession stands.
- All children 8<sup>th</sup> grade and below must be accompanied by an adult in order to be allowed entrance into an extra-curricular event. If not accompanied by an adult, the child will not be allowed in the gates.

## **Student Section Procedures and Expectations**

- Students that elect to sit in the student section, not with their family members, will be required to maintain 6 feet of social distancing and will be required to wear a mask.
- Teacher attendants will be present to monitor the student section for compliance.

## **Employees, Staff, and Volunteer Safety Measures**

- All employees, staff workers, and volunteers will be expected to wear a face covering at all times.
- Concession stands will be available and run by school booster organizations.
  - Staff/workers operating concession stands will be screened pursuant to Paragraph I(b)(iii) of Executive Order 1491.
  - Staff/workers operating concession stands will be required to wear the face covering
  - Social distancing shall be observed by customers/guests waiting in line at the concession stand
  - Customers/guests will not be allowed to congregate in the concession stand area
- Local law enforcement will be present on campus ensuring limitations contained in this document and Executive Order 1519 are observed and enforced, in coordination with school administration.
