

Austin - Prater Memorial Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Austin-Prater Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Anthony Austin and Bobby Prater. Their families established a memorial scholarship in 2016, to be awarded annually to a deserving high school senior from Bledsoe County, Tennessee. The applicant must be entering the field of study in agriculture, agronomy, veterinary medicine or the business of farming.

Both Anthony and Bobby realized that our children are the future. They both were not only parents, they were amazing fathers that worked hard all their lives, provided for their families, raised their children and instilled those same characteristics in them as they were taught growing up.

Anthony married Jeanette (Bobby's sister) on April 20, 1974. They raised five wonderful daughters together. While working full time, raising five daughters, and running their small farm, Anthony took time out of the day to also care for his elderly grandmother. He took the time to teach these girls the value of an education and taught them work ethics on how to be successful. He taught them by example how to be responsible, treat others how you want to be treated and how to be a valuable part of your community and family.

Bobby married Sandra (Cole) on November 3, 1972 and they raised two boys. They raised both boys with the same guiding principals. Hard work, getting a good education and determination to succeed while at the same time helping others to do the same were the building blocks of success in life and something that was instilled within their own families.

These 2 men raised 7 children who are making a difference in their communities and their families. They have also been examples for their children and now even grandchildren's lives.

There were no projects or issues that came up around their farms that these men could not solve. They were not only farmers, there seemed to be a little engineer, gardener, veterinarian in them as well, which I truly believe that in order to be a farmer, these other traits are just in the blood. Both Anthony and Bobby were both very active in the Bledsoe County Cattlemen's Association and were great friends with many of the local farmers in Bledsoe County. This scholarship is being established to keep their legacy alive.

The Austin-Prater Memorial Scholarship is funded by generous donations from the friends and family of Anthony and Bobby. The objective of the scholarship is to honor both Anthony and Bobby's dedication to agriculture, agronomy and the business of farming. Continued support of the scholarship comes from private donations from the family and friends of Anthony and Bobby.

Deserving high school seniors in Bledsoe County will have the opportunity to complete the application process. Qualified applicants must have a permanent address within Bledsoe County. Ranking of applicants will be based on the embodiment of Anthony and Bobby's beliefs in agriculture, autonomy and/or the farming community.

The Austin-Prater Memorial Scholarship was established in 2016 following the sudden passing of both Anthony and Bobby. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals enrolling for undergraduate study in community colleges, and universities.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on financial need, academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in community volunteer hours.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Austin-Prater Memorial Scholarship awards the scholarship on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: academic accomplishments, community service, references, personal essay and financial need. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the college or university. The scholarship is awarded at the beginning of the Fall and Spring semester in the amount of \$500. The recipient would receive a total of \$1,000 per year up to a maximum of \$4,000 over a four-year period.

In order for the scholarship funds to be paid to the school, the recipient must mail proof of acceptance from the college / university showing current enrollment as well as the classes enrolled for the upcoming semester. This must be mailed to Austin Prater Scholarship Fund, P.O. Box 8021, Chattanooga, TN 37414. At the end of each semester, the recipient must then mail an official transcript from the previous semester. The recipient must maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 or greater in order to continue to receive the scholarship funds. If the GPA falls below 3.0, the recipient will forfeit the scholarship and will not be eligible for any additional funds. If you withdraw from school or change your major to something other than agriculture, agronomy or business of farming, you forfeit the scholarship at that time and no additional funds would be awarded.

The recipient must also provide any information needed to pay funds to the college university, including but not limited to; student ID number, SSN, address and phone number to bursar's office, etc.

** All transcripts and documents listed above must be received by the Austin Prater Scholarship Fund at least 3 weeks prior to the beginning of the semester in order for funds to be paid to the recipients account in a timely manner.

CRITERIA

- 1. Applicants must have permanent residence status in Bledsoe County, Tennessee, and must be a permanent resident of the United States.
- 2. Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the upcoming academic semester.
- 4. Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application postmarked by, April 15, 2018
- 5. Applicants must complete a minimum 500 word essay on "Future / Life Goals"

TIMELINE

1. Applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2018. (NO EXCEPTIONS)

APPLICATION PROCESS

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- 1. Completed application form
- 2. Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution.
- 3. Applicant photograph
- 4. Two letters of recommendation. Letters from family members are NOT eligible.
- 5. Proof of acceptance and enrollment from a college / university
- 6. A minimum of 500 word essay.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- 1. The correct mailing address for the applicant.
- 2. Official awarding of scholarship will be announced during Class Night at Bledsoe County High School. Date of be announced.

Deadline for the application is **April 15**, **2018**. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
