

Special School Board Minutes
Jackson County Central Schools
ISD #2895
November 14th, 2016

The Jackson County Central School Board held their special meeting to canvass the results of the 2016 election of the School Board of Jackson County Central Public Schools on Monday, November 14th, 2016, at 6:00 p.m. in the JCC High School Board Room.

Chair Thrush called the meeting to order at 6:11 p.m.

Members present: Holli Arp, Rhonda Moore, Jody Thrush, Kirk Dunlavey, Jeff Johnson, and Brad Anderson, and Tim Thurmer. Absent: None. Others present: High School Principal Larry Traetow.

Motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Arp to approve the agenda as presented. All members present yes, motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Johnson and seconded Dunlavey to approve the Resolution Canvassing Returns of Votes of School District General Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 with the following:

ROLL CALL VOTE. Members voting yes: Moore, Anderson, Arp, Thrush, Thurmer, Johnson, and Dunlavey. Members voting no: None. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Arp to approve the Resolution Canvassing Returns of Votes of School District Special Election.

A total of 3,964 voters of the district voted at said election on the question of “Shall the renewal of the revenue proposed by the Board of Independent School District No. 2895 be approved?” “The Board of Independent School District No. 2895, Jackson County Central, has proposed to renew its referendum revenue authorization which is set to expire in 2017, in an amount equal to \$284.87 per pupil. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be effective for taxes payable in 2018 and be applicable for ten (10) years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law” of which 2,683 voted in favor, 1,281 voted against the same and there were -0- completely blank or defective ballots relating to this question.

ROLL CALL VOTE. Members voting yes: Dunlavey, Johnson, Thurmer, Thrush, Arp, Anderson, and Moore. Members voting no: None. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Thurmer and seconded by Dunlavey to approve the Resolution Canvassing Returns of School District Special Election.

A total of 3,972 voters of the district voted at said election on the question of "Provided that Ballot Question No. 1 is approved, shall the increase in revenue proposed by the Board of Independent School District No. 2895 be approved?" "The Board of Independent School District No. 2895 has proposed to increase its general education revenue by \$175.13 per pupil if Ballot Question No. 1 is approved. The proposed referendum revenue authorization would be effective for taxes payable in 2018 and be applicable for ten (10) years unless otherwise revoked or reduced as provided by law" of which 2,016 voted in favor, 1,956 voted against the same and there were -0- completely blank or defective ballots relating to this question.

ROLL CALL VOTE. Members voting yes: Moore, Anderson, Arp, Thrush, Thurmer, Johnson, and Dunlavey. Members voting no: None. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Dunlavey and seconded by Moore to adjourn the meeting at 6:14 p.m. All members present yes, motion carried unanimously.
