A Board of Education meeting was held on Tuesday, May 27, 2014, at Wolcott High School. In attendance were: Patricia Najarian, Chairman of the Board; Gloria Gubitosi, Vice Chairman of the Board; Cynthia Mancini, Secretary of the Board; Gloria Clair, Lori DelBuono, and Roberta Leonard, all Board members. Also in attendance: Joseph Macary, Superintendent of Schools; Joseph Monroe, Principal of Wolcott High School; Deborah Osvald, Assistant Principal of Wolcott High School; Shawn Simpson, Assistant Principal of Tyrrell Middle School; Holly Wrenn, Principal of Alcott School; Robert Nagashima, Principal of Wakelee School; Wendie Rodriguez, Supervisor of Special Education; Jodi Giglio, Wakelee Teacher; a WEA Representative; and Joan Gray, Board Clerk.

The regular Board meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m., the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Superintendent's Report:

Ms. Giglio explained to the Board how the Grade 4 students at Wakelee researched specific states for Wakelee's State Fair being held June 2nd at the school. Wakelee Students, Erin Manzolli and Emma Simpson reported on Nebraska; Ashley Page and Alexandria Maisto reported on Colorado; and Joseph Garbus and Elian Medina reported on Washington. They gave the Board specific facts about the state each group studied.

The Principals gave two minute updates on their schools. Mr. Nagashima reported for Wakelee and Frisbie, and Mr. Simpson reported for Tyrrell.

The Smarter Balanced Assessment testing has been completed in Grades 4, 5, 7, 8, and 11. Students in Grades 3 and 6 will finish on June 6th.

Wolcott Summer Studies is starting on June 30th. The Program is held at Tyrrell Middle School for five weeks from 8:00 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. Monday to Friday.

Graduation for Tyrrell Middle School will be June 24th at 4:00 p.m. in Tyrrell's Gymnasium and graduation for Wolcott High School will be June 24th at 7:00 p.m. at the high school on Monroe Field (weather permitting). The last day of school for all students is Tuesday, June 24, 2014. June 23 and 24 will be early dismissal days for students.
