

Co-sponsored by the Ottertrail Riders Club, this course covers operating procedures, machine maintenance, rules and regulations, accident prevention, outdoor survival, environmental awareness and code of ethics. Both a written test and a riding performance test must be passed. Minnesota law states all residents born after December 31, 1976, must have a safety certificate to operate a snowmobile anywhere in the state.

Please sign up by Friday, January 3rd in the District Office in person to pick up the DNR form or call (218) 385-4201. The workbook and quizzes are online at snowmobilecourse.com. These materials need to be completed before the riding skills class date below. Follow the instructions online, taking all quizzes, etc. Come to class and bring the Student Registration-Parental Release and Self-Certification Form, the form that shows you passed the course and warm clothes with a helmet. You will receive further instruction that day.
