The school will offer opportunities for parents to take an active role in the student's education by offering a forum for collaboration with staff members , activities that will assist in the student's education beyond school hours, and provide timely information about Title 1 programs.

The following are the main features of a plan that will incorporate strategies for parental involvement that will contribute to shared responsibilities. for the high academic performance of the students.

Strategies that will be used to promote this plan:

1) A parent involvement meeting will take place at the beginning of the year to inform parents in relation to the school's participation in Title 1. At this time the school will distribute and /or review:

- * The schools and parents of the compact student
- * Title 1 funding budget information items /
- * Opportunities to communicate with teachers and the administration to improve the academic performance of your child.

2) Numerous opportunities will be provided during the school year to strengthen building ties between parents and school. These will include:

- * Parent volunteers will serve on the Title I / Leadership committee throughout the year to advise on all Title 1 parent involvement issues.
- * Teacher suggestions for activities / materials for parents to involve their students in the home in their educational development.
- * A parent resource room has been established to allow parents to review reading and math materials to take home to work with their children.

- * Students with perfect attendance will be recognized and will receive some type of award at the end of each nine weeks during the school year. and put your picture on the school website.
- * Parents can meet with the teacher thirty minutes before school, during teacher planning time or thirty minutes after the end of the school day. Teachers will need a one-day notice for meetings.
- * Parents are invited to attend students class each year for learning / day / night class activities to include: Reading, Science, art, physical education, music and as planned on various dates throughout the year.
- * The school will provide a summer reading intervention program so that students have time to improve reading performance based on the identified areas through the following assessments: DIBELS, Scantron Performance Series and formal class work.
- * The school will provide a K camp for all new registered K students to prepare students for Kindergarten.

3) As a Title 1 school-wide school, a survey will be distributed at the end of the year to all parents. Comments on this survey will allow the school to evaluate the Title 1 program; In addition, the school will make changes to improve Title 1 services based on the responses.

This plan will be updated annually to reflect the dynamic needs of parents and the school.
