Assigned Play: _____

Overview: You will be assigned a group in which to work. In your group, you will assign character roles to each member. Some members may have more than one character. It is your job as a group to decide. Once you have designated the characters, you will be responsible for creating a different ending for the play that you have been assigned.

Part I:

As a group, you need to write a brief ending to the play. You will do this as a summary; not in dialogue. You will simply discuss in detail what will happen in your ending. You will also need to create a name for this ending, which will be considered the final scene.

Part II:

As a group, you will look over your summary, and you will start working on the dialogue for the play. Each individual is responsible for creating his/her parts. Each person should record a copy of his/her parts for the play because an individual grade will be given based on this work.

Part III:

All individual parts of the play will be compiled into one final script. **All individual copies must be turned in with the final copy.** The final copy should be typed in the following order:

Cover Page:

- Title of the Final Scene
- Names of all group participants and their assigned roles
- Brief Summary of the ending (From part I)

Play:

- All dialogue as assigned to each character
- EX:

JOHN. I thought you'd be my friend forever
SUE. Well all good things come to an end, don't they?

Part IV:

The entire group will perform the play for the class - **(graded on performance and content)**

Grade:

The group project and performance is worth a total of **250 points**; the individual parts that are turned in as mentioned above will be worth **50 points**. **The total project grade is 300 points**, but it will be converted into a score out of 100 for your EQT grade.
