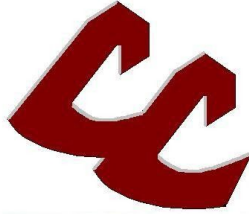


CENTRAL BAND BINGO!!!



1. Choose any **five** squares from the bingo board to complete throughout the week.

FlipGrid is the preferred method for videos but if you are not able to use that, you may email it.

Again, the assignment this week is to complete **any** 5 squares on the board **but** if your chosen activities create **BINGO** (5 squares in a row, diagonally, vertically, or horizontally), your name will be placed on the BINGO Award List and your name will also be entered for a chance to win a BOSE SoundLink Micro Speaker!

(minimum 1 minute)
Find a piece you played in middle school. Play it and see how much you've grown! (record it)	Teach a family member to count and clap rhythms. Write your own 8 measure rhythm and record yourselves performing it together.	Pick a 20 second song to wash your hands to. Record yourself washing your hands to this song! Pick 2 of these ways to play your chromatic scale, record and send: -jogging in place -balancing on one leg -lying on the floor

Lizzo-flute, Neil Armstrong- baritone). Find a creative way to share what you've learned about them. (video, poster, etc.)	Contact an Alumni Band Member and write a paper on what they are doing now (college, major, work force, military, interesting facts, etc)	Practice marching fundamentals on your own band field* *house, backyard, driveway, etc. (Record it and be creative!)	Make a TikTok playing your instrument. (download and share with us!)
Research a college band program. What opportunities do they offer? Ensembles? Scholarships?	Pick one of your pieces from LGPE and perform it for your pet. (record it)	Call (or facetime, skype, etc.) a family member/friend who lives far away and play a song for them on your instrument. (record it)	Use the Acapella app to record a piece with friends (up to 9 people can contribute to one video). (Download and send)	Learn and perform the theme song from your favorite TV show. (record it)
