

Good evening middle school and high school parents and students of the Randolph County School System,

This is Stephen Gainey. I am calling as a follow-up to my telephone message on 9/10/20:

Between now and the end of the day on 9/25/20, parents and students at the middle school and high school levels will be required to make a decision regarding the use of one of the following two plans:

Plan #1 A student participates in face-to-face instruction on his or her school's campus for two days per week and three days of remote instruction per week

**OR**

Plan #2 A student participates in 100% remote instruction. In other words, the student does not come to campus on any day of the week and engages in remote instruction for every day of the week.

Effective 9/28/20, middle school students and high school students will be required to use only one of these plans. As a result, effective 9/28/20, middle school students and high school students will no longer be permitted to move from one plan to the other one. Students must commit to one of these plans for the remainder of the time that our school system deals with the COVID-19 pandemic no later than 9/25/20. Parents, if you do not want your child's current plan to change, you do not need to do anything by 9/25/20. However, if you wish to change your child's current plan, you need to contact his or her school no later than 9/25/20.

As a reminder, the deadline for the previously-noted decision is 9/25/20. Parents should contact their child's school regarding their decision.

On another note, at the Board of Education meeting on 9/21/20, the Board of Education decided to allow middle school students and high school students to make one change after their decision on 9/25/20. However, the one change can only be to move from the plan with 100% remote instruction per week to the plan with 2 days of face-to-face instruction with three days of remote instruction per week.
