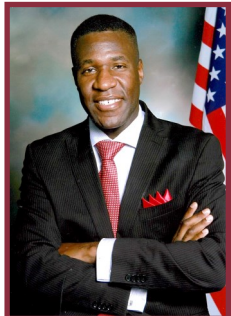

MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT



Greetings Jennings School District Students, Staff, Parents and Stakeholder: This 2018-19 School Year will be another amazing time of learning, success, and accomplishments for our community. True to our theme, we have placed **Students First and WE Enlighten, Empower, and Engage the Community with Excellence in Education**. Our short-term mission is to continue to be the best urban school district in the nation and with accreditation with distinction. Because of everyone's support and hard work, we are starting to perform in this range in some areas and we know that it is possible. Although state APR will not be back until nearly the end of 1st semester, there have already been a number of awards and achievements to celebrate as signs of excellence:

- **Jennings School District has received the NAF National Model Academy Award, Missouri Community Action Network Award, and Honorable Mention and A Proclamation on the floor of the Missouri House of Representatives for our outstanding accomplishments in 2017-18 School Year. Jennings School District is still at the top** in the region for graduation rates for 2018—with 100% graduation and career or college placements in post-secondary education.
 - **CVS Mock Store Ribbon Cutting Ceremony** - Jennings is the first school district to open a mock pharmacy in the state of Missouri to have this partnership.
 - **Little Medical School** worked with third graders at Fairview Elementary to simulate what it means to be a medical doctor. Students received their white coat, diploma and recited the Hippocratic Oath during a summer graduation ceremony.
 - **Building Futures** helped to teach classes at the elementary level this summer forming our first Jennings K-12 Career Prep Construction Academy Pathway with students doing work-based learning from the elementary through high school level this summer with high school students having paid internships and OSHA and Forklifting Certifications.
 - **NAF Future Ready Lab occurred** for the first time in the state of Missouri with Jennings, KPMG, Mastercard, World Wide Technology, and University of Missouri-St. Louis supporting a class of 19 Jennings Scholars with paid internships.
- We extended learning opportunities for students and staff into July of 2018 with several programs:
- St. Louis Chess Club and Magic House Exhibit in Jennings for the first time served hundreds of children in June and July.
 - Network for Teaching Entrepreneurship Biz Camp was hosted by Jennings School District
 - ShowMe Careers Missouri Chamber of Commerce Teacher Externships
 - NAFNext Conference and Presentations
 - Project Lead the Way Teacher Training and Curriculum from elementary through high school.

Truly, our work in Jennings is changing the trajectory of our children, community and country. Thank you for making Jennings the best school district in the state and region. Thank you for your exceptional support and hard work. It is a privilege to serve the Jennings community with you. I thank you in advance for making the 2018-19 school year amazing and for helping Jennings reach the destination of accreditation with distinction.

2017-2018 Top Accomplishments

- Jennings School District is the first and only district in Missouri with two Health Based Clinics for free dental, vision, mental, and medical healthcare for students PreK to 12 grade.
- Fairview collaborated with the Girl Scouts and became the first elementary school in Jennings to qualify for the national FIRST Robotics Competition.
- Northview Elementary significantly transformed its school climate and received an Honorable Mention from Washington University for MySci implementation and from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for academic achievement.
- Jennings Junior High and JETS became a state and nationally recognized "WE Schools leaders" where staff and students have the opportunity to be global leaders abroad and trip to Africa and Ecuador.
- Jennings School District received the National Academy Foundation (NAF) President's Award with Jennings Senior High School receiving the distinction of NAF "Model Academy" for the Academy of Health Sciences and the Jobs for America's Graduates (JAG) High Performer Award.
- Jennings Senior High Warriors Basketball Team won the Class 4 MSHAA District Tournament and placed 3rd in the Class 4 State Championship.
- Jennings School District is #1 in the region for graduation rates with 100% graduation, career or college placements and our first student to graduate from high school with an associates degree (and Cisco Certification).
