Mr. Smith recommended to the board that Jason Vandaveer be hired for head maintenance / custodian for the 2021-2022 school year. A motion was made by Koll, seconded by Sanders to employ Jason Vandaveer for the head maintenance / custodian. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Smallwood-yes; Koll-yes; Eichler-yes; Sanders-yes; Rutherford-yes; Parrott-absent; and Yearout-yes. Motion carried 6 yes, 0 no.

Mr. Smith shared information of applicants that have expressed interest in the evening custodial open position. He plans to have interviews in the next week. He would like approval to hire the best candidate. A motion was made by Koll, seconded by Rutherford to hire the best applicant for the evening custodial position. Roll call vote of motion carried as follows: Smallwood-yes; Koll-yes; Eichler-yes; Sanders-yes; Rutherford-yes; Parrott-absent; and Yearout-yes. Motion carried 6 yes, 0 no.
