I have some highlights for you from the March 23, 2020 school board meeting.

Good progress is being made on the elementary gym renovation project. This project is scheduled to be completed in July.

The board accepted a \$27,500 donation from the Elementary PTO. The board also amended the budget to allocate the donation for the purchase of elementary playground equipment. The PTO will be accepting donations through April 1st.

A new lease for chromebooks was approved by the board. All students in grades 2-12 will receive new chromebooks next school year.

The Always Changing and Growing Up Puberty Education Videos were approved as recommended by the School Health Advisory Committee (SHAC). Parents will receive notification of these videos and have the opportunity to view and opt their child out before the videos are shown. 5th grade boys and girls will be shown these videos separately.

A resolution to grant the superintendent authority to pay employees during the current school closure was approved by the board.

Contracts for the 2020-2021 school year were approved for teachers, counselors, and school nurse.

I am so grateful to everyone for pulling together to make the best of this coronavirus situation. We will continue to learn and work together to provide our students with the best learning experience possible!
