II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

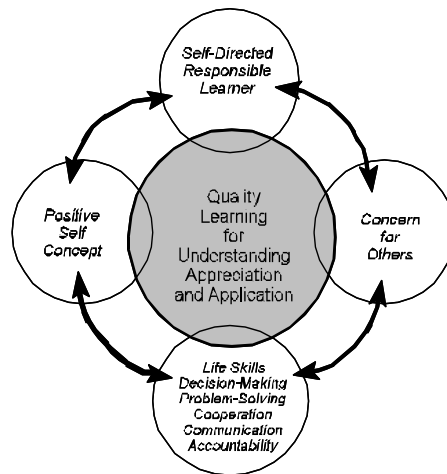
The school board believes that a mission *and vision* statements should be adopted. The mission *and vision* statements should be based on the beliefs and values of the community, direct any change effort and be the basis on which decisions are made. The school board, on behalf of and with extensive participation by the community, should develop a consensus among its members regarding the nature of the enterprise the school board governs, the purposes it serves, the constituencies it should consider, including student representation, and the results it intends to produce.

The purpose of education is to help individuals acquire knowledge, skills, and positive attitudes toward self and others that will enable them to solve problems, think creatively, continue to learn, and develop maximum potential for learning in our ever changing society.



IV. REVIEW

The school board will review the school district's mission *and vision statements* every two years, especially when members of the board change. The school board will conduct a comprehensive review of the mission *and vision statements*, including the beliefs and values of the community, every five to seven years.
