

Mr. Brunenkant's Rules

1. Only talk with permission
 - a. Raise your hand if you have a question or comment.
 - b. If I do not answer right away wait patiently. I see you, but I am explaining the whole slide to the entire class.
 - c. You are not allowed to talk while I am explaining information; not only is it distracting, but it is rude towards your classmates and me.
 - d. If you are having a problem with the seating chart, or a fellow classmate wait until after class to talk to me about the situation.
 - e. You are not allowed under any circumstance to talk during a test or quiz unless you are talking directly to me after I have acknowledged your hand being raised.
 - f. I am available for questions during class work time. Please raise your hand, I will get to you as time allows. If time runs out, I will explain the information after class. ****Please do not yell my name aloud, or say you need help. I see you, I am just helping another student at that moment. If time runs out I will make time to answer your question.****

2. Do not get out of your seat during lecture
 - a. If a pencil needs to be sharpened ask for permission after I am done lecturing on the current slide. (I will allow time for you to write slide)
 - b. If a Kleenex is needed please raise your hand to ask me before getting out of seat.
 - c. Again, I am available for questions during class work time. Please raise your hand, I will get to you as time allows. If time runs out, I will explain the information after class. ****Please do not complain about time, if you truly want help I will MAKE time for you****

3. Be in seat when you enter the classroom
 - a. You need to be in your ASSIGNED seat.
 - b. ****If you are not in your assigned seat when the tardy bell rings, you will be marked tardy.**
 - c. The only time a tardy will be accepted is when you have a note from another teacher explaining why you were late to my class.

4. Please be prepared for class.
 - a. Make sure you have a pencil and paper. If you do not, I will supply the required material, however if it is a reoccurring problem I will be calling home.
 - b. You also need your binder for class everyday (This is extremely important towards your overall grade in my class).
 - c. Bring your computer to class every day.
 - d. Not only do you need to have material ready; make sure your attention and intelligence is ready every day to learn!

5. Turn your assignments in on time.
 - a. The work will be on Schoology for missing assignments.
 - b. The best you can receive is 20 percent off of a late assignment.
 - c. If late assignments become a habitual problem (two at any given time , or one more than a week late) you will receive break detention to make up the assignments.
 - d. If you are quarantined you will have time to make up the work.
6. Cell phones are not to be out in my class
 - a. Cell Phones will be turned in at the beginning of class.
 - b. If I catch you with your cell phone, I will take it to the office.
 - c. There is no exception on this rule.
7. There will be no food or drink in my class unless it is approved by myself
 - a. Only water will be allowed in my class, unless there is a special occasion.
 - b. If I do allow food in the class you must throw away your wrappers.

Discipline plan: My rules are very easy to follow. If you follow these rules the discipline plan will never come into effect.

1. Warning: You will tell me what rule you broke, and how you broke it. This is your free pass.
2. Writing assignment: If I have to discipline you more than once, then you will write the rule you previously broke fifteen times during classwork time, or after class. It is due the next day. (If you broke more than one rule, you will write both)
3. Calling home: If you continue to be a behavior problem in my class, I will be calling home, and discussing your actions with your parents. We may set up a meeting with your parents as well.
4. Write up: If the behavior problems continue than you will be written up**The warnings do not start over each day.

Example: If you get a warning on Monday for talking without permission on Monday, and Wednesday you talk again without permission, you will be writing the rule you broke 15 times.
