

Stakeholder Engagement Meeting 2

National Board Certification & Stakeholder Engagement



The second Robert Lee ISD Teacher Incentive Allotment stakeholder engagement meeting was held on January 6, 2021. The purpose of the meeting was to continue to inform participants about the components of the Teacher Incentive Allotment and to review stakeholder input from the survey that was sent out after the first meeting. Several of our meetings were held after we participated in a zoom meeting presented by Region 15, this being one of several trainings they offered for local districts. During the training, participants were divided up into breakout sessions to continue conversations about various components of the local designation system. The breakout sessions included Stakeholder Engagement and the National Board Certification process.

Once the Region 15 training was completed, our principals met with campus teachers and community members during a site based meeting to share the information and to give the stakeholders an opportunity for input and clarifications. Survey results were shared with discussion on student growth and teacher observation. Several student growth measures were looked at, however, the pre-test and post-test using STAAR, TX-KEA, Circle, and Content Based Assessments (CBA) received a lot of feedback.

Procedures for receiving a National Board Certification were shared with all and teachers with an NBC would be included under TIA guidelines as a Recognized designation. We also continued our sharing of website resources and scheduled individual meetings with Principals for those requesting.
