imagination”

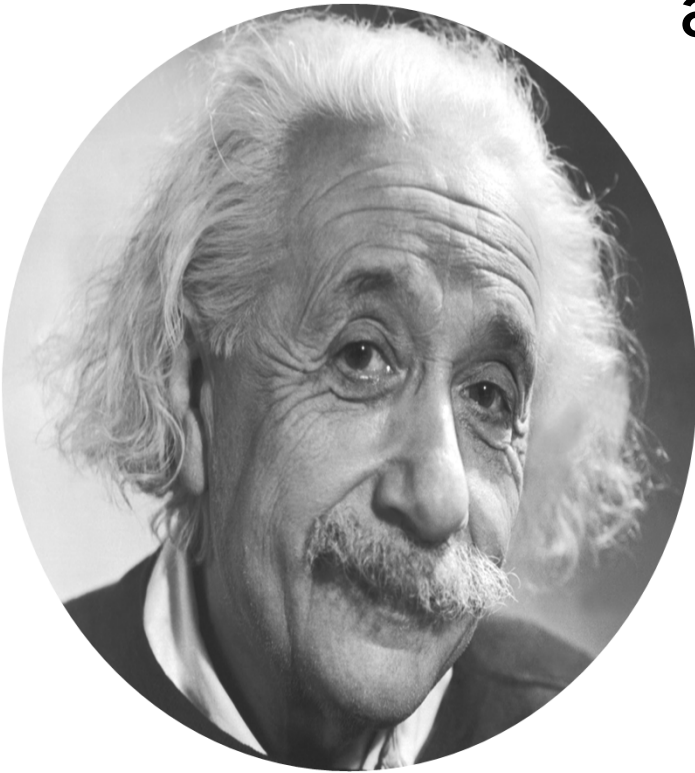


Albert Einstein

had his first book

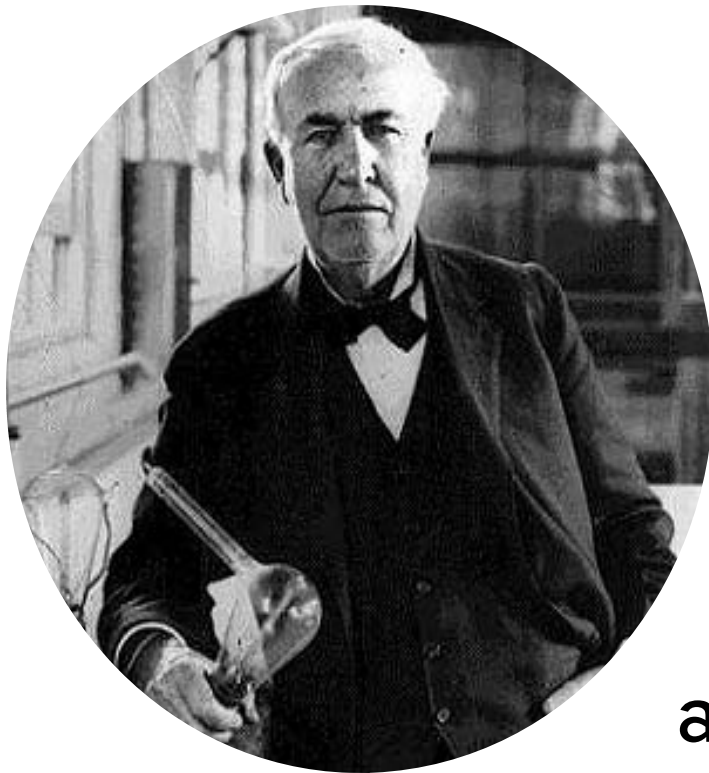
To Think That I Saw It

what it can become.”



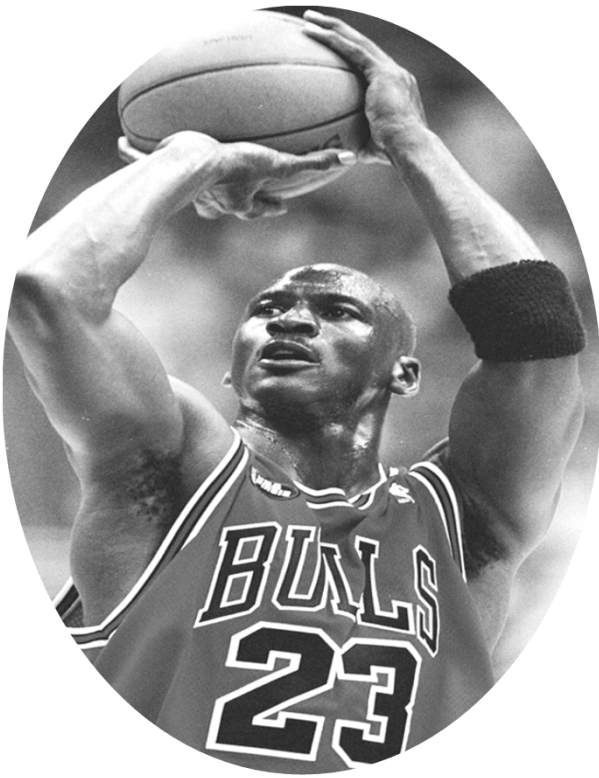
Thomas Edison
