MCLSDP Literacy Grant

Improving Literacy

The Montana Office of Public Instruction (OPI) awarded Boulder Elementary School a grant through the Montana Comprehensive Literacy State Development Project (MCLSDP). The state of Montana received a 5-year, \$50 million federal Striving Readers Comprehensive State Development Program grant from the U.S. Department of Education which funds MCLSDP awards. According to the OPI website, the purpose is to advance literacy skills using evidence-based practices, strategies, and interventions for all children, preschool to grade 12, with an emphasis on disadvantaged children.

Boulder Elementary School has established a School Leadership Team to ensure implementation of the MCLSDP grant. A copy of the MCLSDP grant can be found online at our website.



The Boulder Elementary School Leadership team will ensure the following will be implemented and supported: Quality Instruction, Evidence Based Strategies, Practices and Interventions, Community and Family Engagement, and improving School Quality, Climate and Communication.

The School Leadership Team is ensuring implementation of the grant through monthly meetings, planning professional development activities, and ensuring implementation of evidence based practices. Cheryl Breker has been hired as a full-time instructional coach and Rochelle Hesford has been hired as our part-time Family Engagement Coordinator.
