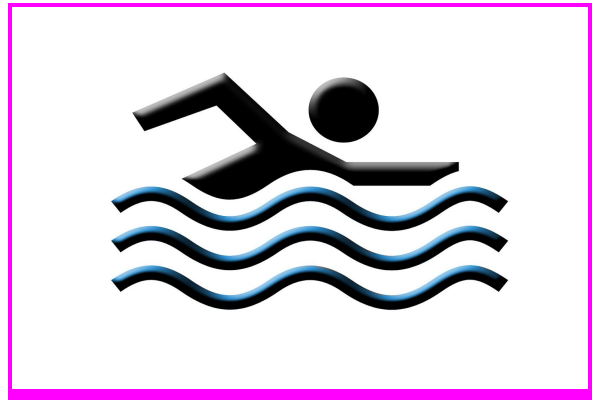

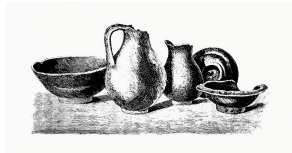
Swimming Lessons
