Donna Coco from Coleridge Elementary spoke of concerns regarding the budget proposal of lowering support staff by 80% in current budget. She requested to please consider keeping support staff such as media and teacher assistants at 100%.

Instruction

2012-2014 Technology Plan - First Reading

Nan York, Director of Media/Technology presented the first reading of the 2012-2014 Technology Plan. Ms. York stated the state does the objectives and Randolph County Schools writes the plan with five strategic priorities. The technology plan will need to be approved by June 30, 2012 and will be brought back to the board at the June Board of Education meeting for approval.

Administration

2012-2013 Board of Education Meeting Schedule

Mr. Andrews presented the 2012-2013 Board of Education Meeting dates to include Public Forums and Superintendent Community Trustees meeting dates. G. Mason made a motion seconded by M. Lambeth to approve the dates as presented. Motion carried: 7-0.

Southeastern Randolph Middle School Mascot/Colors

Mr. Andrews presented on behalf of the faculty and staff at Southeastern Randolph Middle to respectfully request permission to actively investigate and change their school mascot and colors to match Eastern Randolph High School. Through this request it is believed this change would dramatically improve school pride and community support. Information presented would not require any extra funding, but would occur in phases through donations, fundraising, grants, and/or local school funds. The Principal, Mr. Larry Chappel, along with other support team were available to answer any questions or concerns. G. Mason made a motion seconded by G. Cook to approve the request as presented. Motion carried: 7-0.

Child Nutrition Lunch Prices

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations and Donna Osborne, Director of Child Nutrition shared that due to USDA Federal Requirements Randolph County schools will be forced to make some changes due to the Reauthorization Act of 2010. Currently the meal prices are \$1.75 for elementary and \$1.90 for middle/high. USDA is requiring the charge for paid meals to equal the difference in the reimbursement between free and paid lunches. The recommendation was to increase the meal prices to \$1.90 for elementary and \$2.00 for grades 6-12 for the 2012-2013 school year. We are also looking to have increases over the next couple of years. Information was also given to the Board to show comparisons of meal prices in the

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surrounding counties. G. Mason made a motion seconded by J. Johnson to approve the information shared regarding changes in meal prices for the 2012-2013 school year. Motion carried: 7-0.

2013-2014 School Calendar Update

Mr. Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations presented and update on the 2013-2014 calendar. There is information that changes to the calendar guidelines could take place during the legislative session. To avoid any confusion Mr. Trotter stated it would be best to bring to the Board the recommendation at the June Board Meeting in hopes of knowing what the final requirements will be. E. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Cook to wait until information is received from Raleigh before proceeding. Motion carried: 7-0.

Ramseur Elementary Use of Facilities Agreement

Mr. Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, brought back information shared with the Board in October regarding a facilities agreement between Ramseur Elementary and First Christian Church (FCC) for use of the outdoor ball field for community events. The term of the agreement would be for three years with the option to renew at the end of the third year. All requests for improvement would be made in writing and approved by the school system prior to any work being completed. All utilities for the field area will be placed in FCC's name. Events planned by the church will not conflict with any school events. Mr. Trotter stated this will be a positive impact on Ramseur School, First Christian Church and provide outreach opportunities to the community. E. Coltrane made a motion seconded by G. Mason to approve the use of facilities agreement (3 year contract) with First Christian Church in Ramseur. Motion carried: 7-0.

2012-2013 Budget Update

Mr. Lowe, Finance Officer, gave an update to the Board regarding meetings and information received from Raleigh. He stated for the first time in four years the budget information is positive. Mr. Lowe shared the discretionary reduction line item that included three different amounts presented at a previous board work session that the \$55.00 amount is more in line with the numbers from Raleigh. Based on information from Mr. Price our reversion would not increase and may be lower. The House Budget is going to try to assist public education and replace dollars that is not available this year. Mr. Lowe spoke positive of being able to place \$900K back into the budget. The Senate budget should be tighter, but \$900K figure looks good. M. Lambeth made a motion seconded by G. Mason that based upon the update of information presented to take the dollars of discretionary reduction/reversion off the table to eliminate from the reduction plan. Motion carried: 7-0.

CLOSED

G. Cook made a motion seconded by J. Johnson to go into closed session for the purpose of considering a personnel matter that involves an officer or employee of this board as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(6). Motion carried: 7-0.
