## Title I Programs

### I. Technology

- a. **Imagine Learning** - A computer based program that will allow students to build core literacy and math skills.
- b. **i-Ready** - A computer based program that utilizes student test data to find and fix learning gaps. This program allows teachers to personalize instruction to meet student's individual needs.
- c. **Interactive TV**- Students/teachers access computer programs to enhance student learning and build vital reading/math skills.

### II. Monitoring Students

- a. **At Risk Students** - Our staff makes every effort to monitor student progress by working with individual students who are at risk.
- b. **Title I** - Title I staff monitors student progress and work alongside teachers to meet the needs of all students.
- c. **TST** - Instructional interventions given to students to enrich their learning and keep them on grade level.
- d. **District Assessments/MKAS & i-Ready** - computerized assessments to determine a student's language arts and math skill level. Tests are given multiple times throughout the year and teachers will use this test data to individualize student instruction.

### III. Title I Program

- a. **Parent Meetings** - Parent volunteers and Title I staff discuss the Parental Involvement policy, parent compact, parent interest survey as well as brainstorming ideas to implement throughout the school year.
- b. **Parent Involvement Committee** - This committee helps develop activities to involve parents and share ideas for the coming school year.
- c. **School-Parent Compact** - list ways to support a partnership between home and school resulting in a shared responsibility between families and the school to improve student achievement.
- d. **Parent-Teacher Conferences** - Conferences are encouraged for the success of your child. Please phone the school to schedule a conference with your child's teacher, counselor, or principal. Conferences help both the home and school provide information to promote student achievement and well being.
- e. **Report Card** - an overview of the language arts and math standards that students will be expected to master over the course of the school year.
