(November 13th), so far Webster County Schools have had one school related COVID-19 quarantine/COVID-19 positive (H.S. Student) - all students who have primarily been exposed are in quarantine, quarter one report cards went home today, the remote learner report cards were mailed, and Thanksgiving break is November 23-27. Mrs. Downer reported that there was no new news in the Special Education Dept. (Mrs. Ellis). Mrs. Downer also reported that Mrs. Swain was keeping federal programs in line. Mrs. Downer then reported that everything was going good in the CTAE Dept. (Dr. Ingram) and still working on Mr. Baker's lab expenses.
