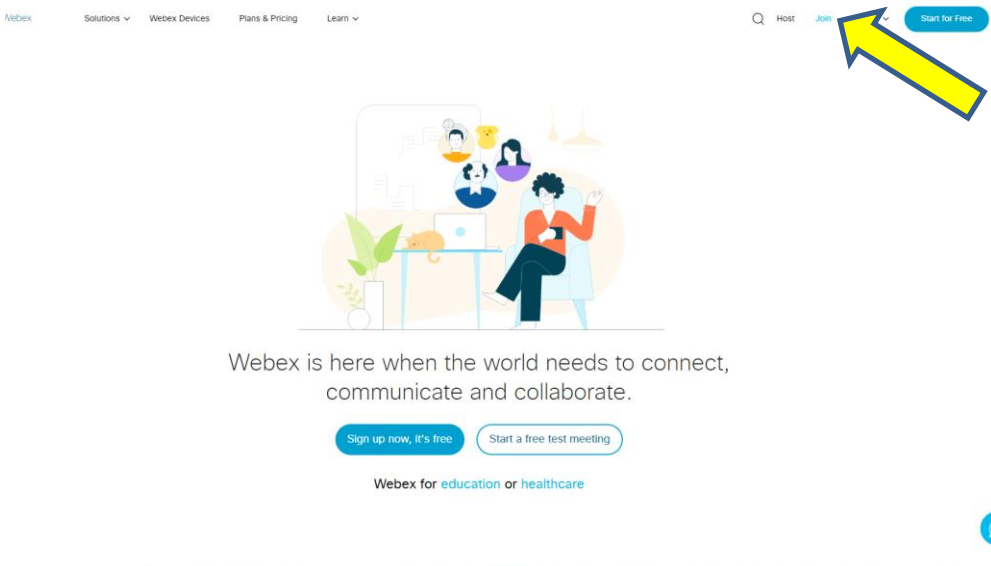

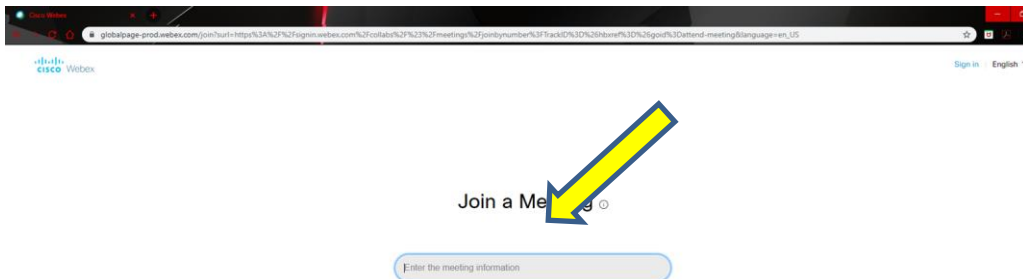
Virtual Tournament Sign In

Competitors will need to enter **2 different sites** for the tournament. First, log in to **WebEx** to see the questions and host. Second, log in to our **livetournament.Perennialmath.com** to enter your answers. WebEx Meeting number and Livetournament Log in Codes will be emailed to the parent along with links to each site in the email. If you cannot get to those sites by clicking on the links, please follow the instructions below.

1. Go to **Webex.com** and click **JOIN** in the top right corner.

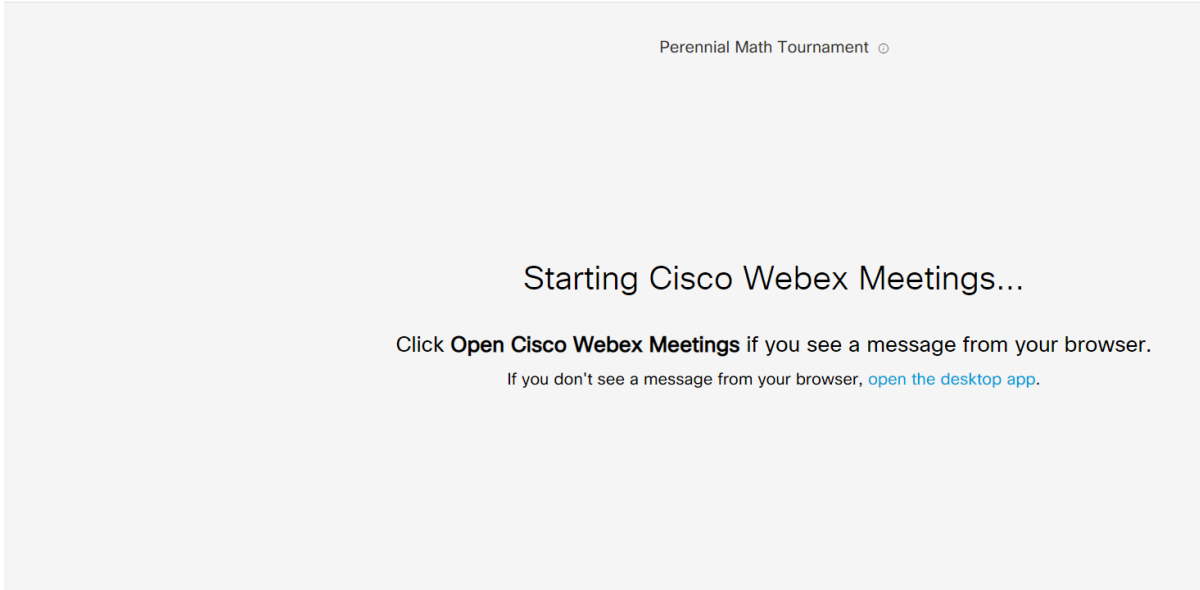


2- Put in the meeting number in the Join a Meeting box

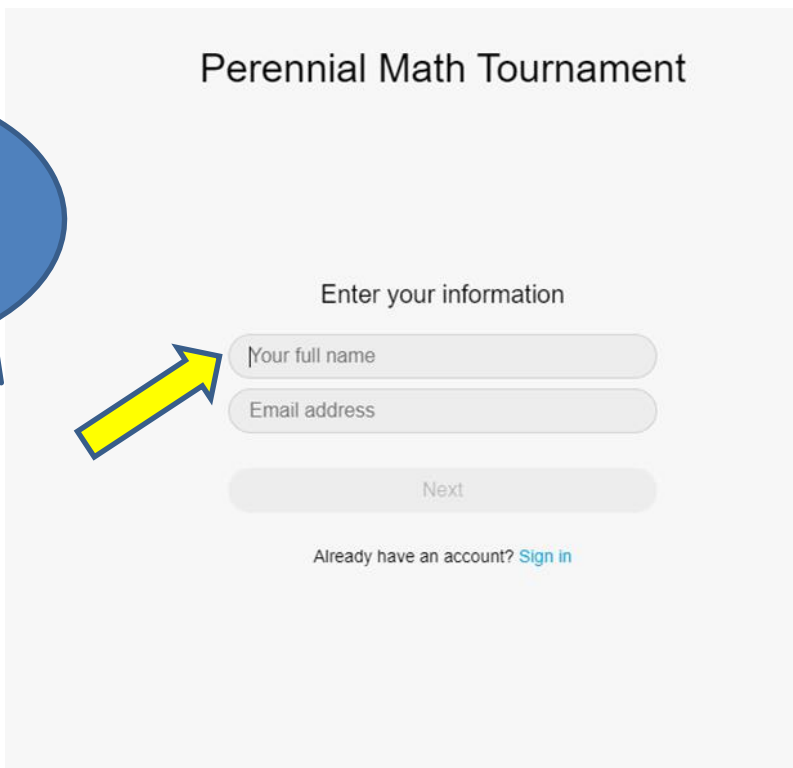




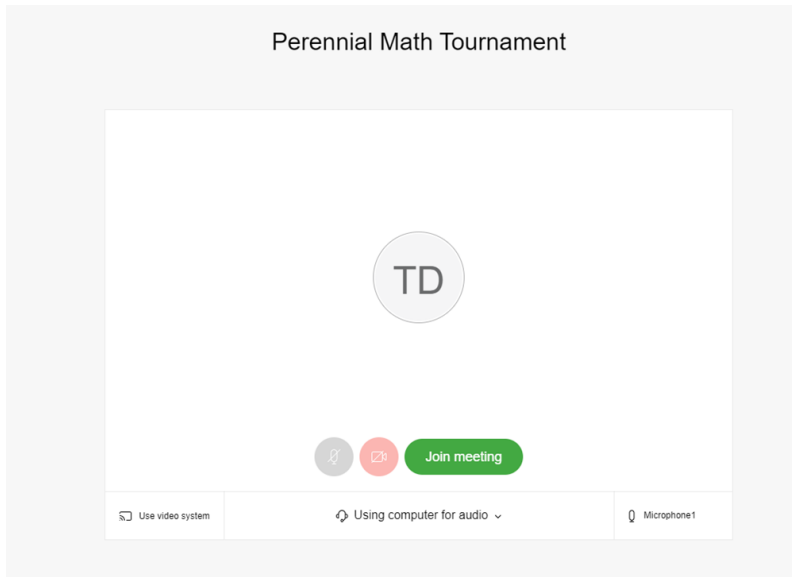
3- You may see a box appear that asks you to **Open the Cisco Webex Meeting** in your browser or open the desktop app. You should try to open WebEx from your browser if possible.



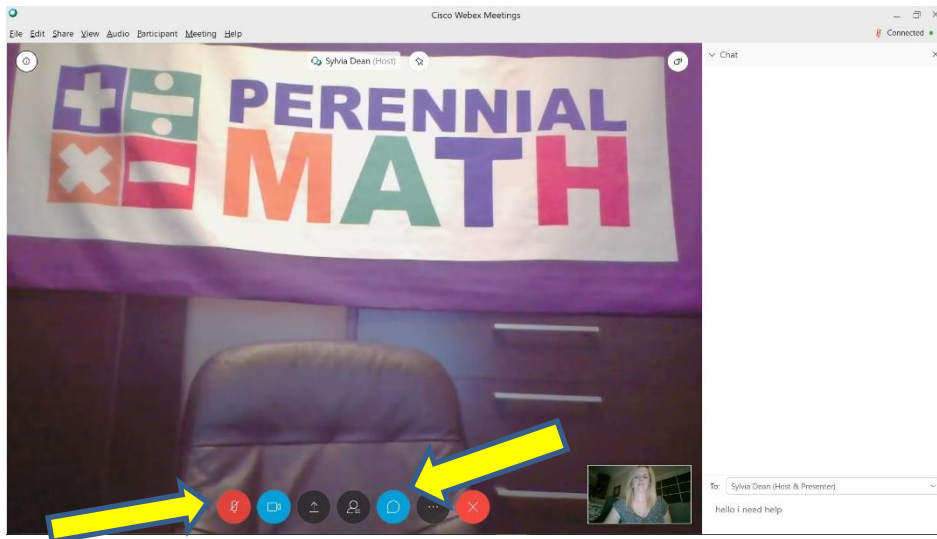
4- Put in your **Student Name**, and the parent email address.



Select the tournament name, student name, and enter the login code that was emailed to you



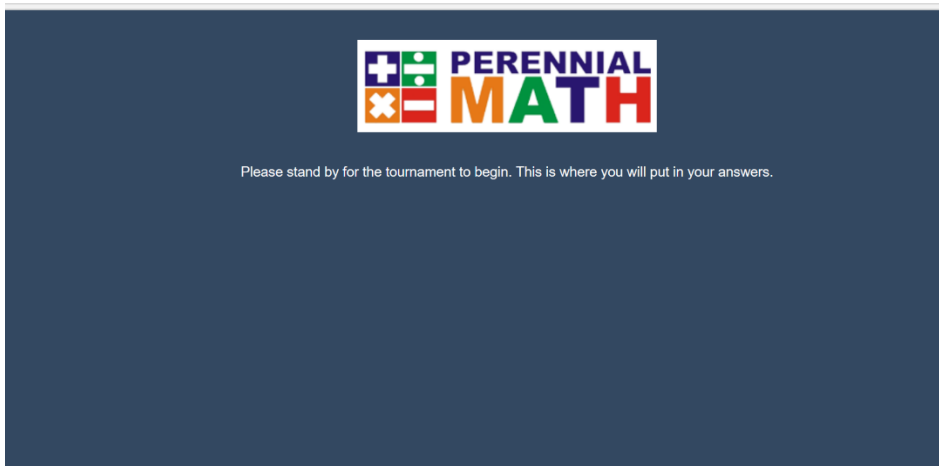

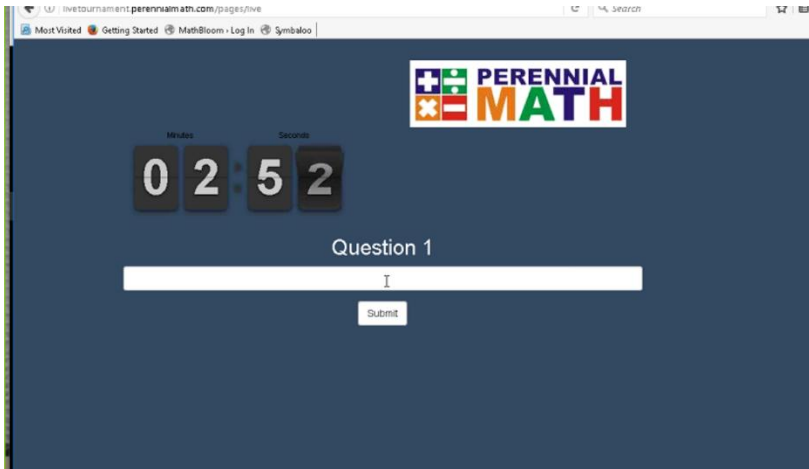
You will come in to our Welcome Screen. It will stay like this until the tournament begins. **PLEASE stay on MUTE**

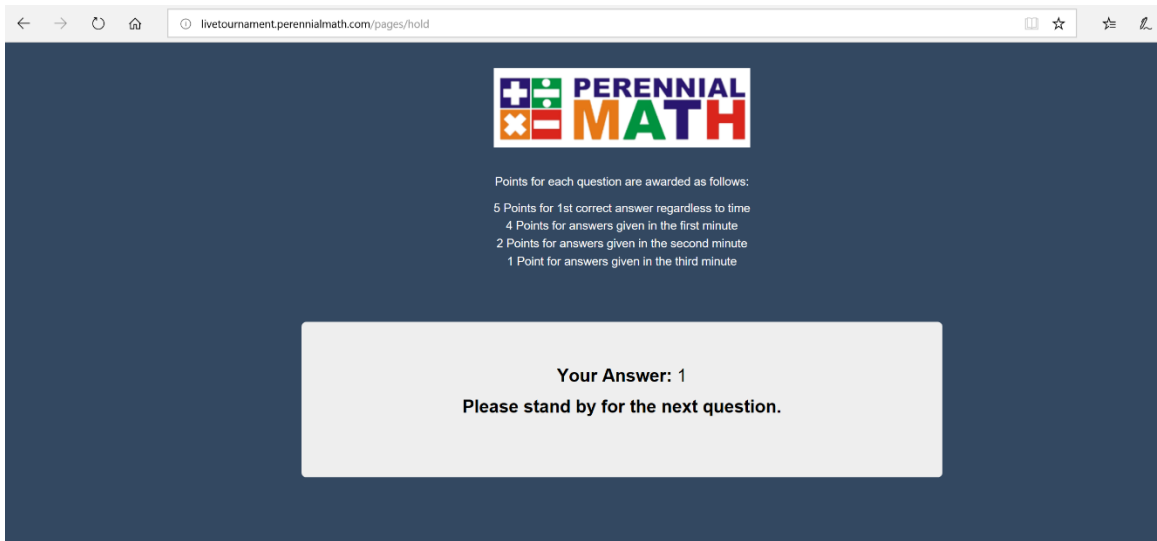




Once we start the first question a timer will appear and you will enter your answer in the box. Once you enter your answer it will calculate your score and send Perennialmath you answer.
