

Scarborough Model Middle School 2020-21 Uniform Policy

Tops

- Shirts must be solid color polo style shirt (long or short sleeves) with no more than a 2 inch monogram (solid)
- Only plain white t-shirts or the SMMS PE t-shirt can be worn under the polo shirt.
- Shirts must be **neatly tucked in** at all times
 - School sponsored organization t-shirts can be worn on designated days.

Pants

- **Khaki** uniform pants only (boys and girls)
- Pants should worn on the natural waist; full length with no rips or fraying.



- **NO Joggers, leggings, or jeggings**
- **NO shorts**
- **NO skinny jeans or tight fitting pants**

- **NO jeggings**
- **No Skirts or Skorts**

BELTS

- **Solid Black or brown** belts only
- **No Oversized belt buckles**



Students that do not follow the uniform policy will face disciplinary measures. If student is not dressed appropriately parents will be called to bring correct uniform. In order to avoid a loss of instructional time, please make sure your child is dressed correctly when he/she comes to school. **The SMMS Administration reserves the right to change or modify the dress code as needed.**

HEADWEAR

- 3-inch Headband is allowed
- Religious Headwear is allowed
- **No hats or hoods Bandanas, scarfs, or Bonnets are allowed (see examples below)**



SOCKS

- Students should wear socks everyday.

FOOTWEAR



- **Brown** leather shoes *or* Lace up athletic shoes **ONLY (see examples above)**
- Slides, Flip Flops, crocs, ballet flats, sandals, boots & slippers **are not allowed**

OUTERWEAR

- Jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts **MAY BE WORN WITHOUT HOODS**
- No outerwear with RIP or inappropriate language or pictures
- **Sweatshirts, sweaters, and jackets worn inside the building must be one of the following colors with no visible logos. They must be: Plain Hunter Green or Plain Gray. NO HOODIES NO BLANKETS.**
- **Long Sleeve undergarments must be white, black, green, or gray.**

Backpacks

- **Students should bring a backpack with school supplies every day.**

ID Badge

- All students will be issued an ID Badge. Replacements cost \$5.
- Badges must be worn each day are needed for breakfast, lunch, checking in, & field trips.

Mobile Device Policy

- Cell phone use is not permitted on campus.
- Must be powered off, not visible, and in purse or book bag.
- Headphones & Bluetooth devices are not allowed and should not be worn.
- Earbuds should not be worn outside of instruction.
- SMMS is not responsible for lost or damaged devices/accessories.
- Devices can be taken by staff if they are being used on campus.
