The Kelliher-Northome Mustangs Football team had four of its members named to the Northern Tri-County All Conference Team.

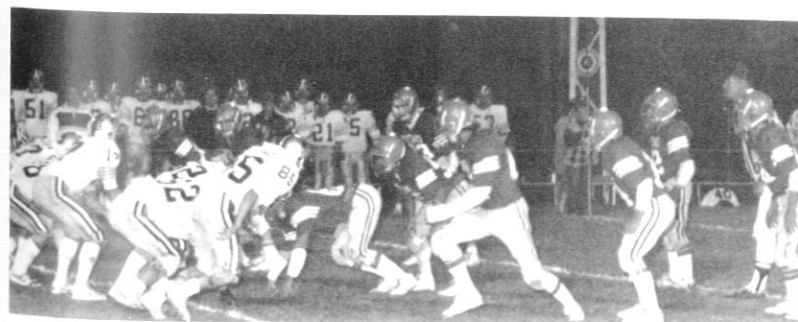
