

# LHHS ACADEMIC (GRADUATION) REQUIREMENTS

One-half credit is awarded upon successful completion (grade of “D” or better) of each semester-long class. (Algebra requires a grade of “C” or better for credit.) A class lasting two semesters (one school year) earns one full credit.
