Cafeterias – Handling of School Lunch Funds

The financial operation of the school lunch program is a direct responsibility of the Board of Education of the Town of New Milford. This responsibility must be exercised through an account under the immediate jurisdiction of the Board. This means that the deposit of receipts and payment of bills must be made through the “special school lunch clearing account” which shall function under the immediate supervision of the Director of Fiscal Services and Director of Food and Nutrition Services.
