1st Day of Classes on March 22, 2021

- ► Hybrid Student Orientation will occur on March 22nd from 8:00am-12:30pm
- Students will have an opportunity to attend each of their classes and receive guidance on schoolwide expectations during the orientation



PHS HYBRID MODEL

Grades 9-12
In-person 4 days & Virtual/In-Person 1 Day

- 5 full days per week (8:00am-3:02pm)
- Hybrid model that combines both in-person and virtual/online learning
- 4 days on campus Monday-Thursday, 1 assigned flex day on campus (as needed) on Friday
- Students will have a consistent schedule of assigned days on campus (Monday-Thursday with Fridays as a flex day)
- Microsoft Class Teams- lesson resources and livestreaming for students that are under required school Quarantine or Isolation
- Properly fitted masks are required on campus
- Social/physical distancing will be practiced by reducing the number of students on campus for in-person learning
- Social emotional learning supports
- Home internet connection needed for Quarantine or Isolation
- District devices provided as needed
- Free breakfast and lunch provided

PHS Hybrid with In-Person Learning

Microsoft Office



- Hybrid students will still use their school accounts through Microsoft Office for completing schoolwork, extra communications from their teachers, email, etc.
- PHS teachers will provide in-person lessons Monday-Thursday to hybrid students with Flex Friday for additional help sessions as scheduled
- Students will still have Class Teams assigned to them that match each course in their schedule (4 full classes & 1 elective)

In-Person Learning Reminders

- Students are required to attend classes inperson Monday-Thursday at the regularly scheduled class time
- Assignments and scheduled help sessions will occur on Flex Fridays
- Dress code needs to be followed
 - School uniform shirt required
 - Properly fitted mask required (covering both nose and mouth)
 - School appropriate clothing
- Classes will follow the normal schedule of 85 minutes per class

Requirements for correct mask wearing How to Wear You

- Must securely fit (no gaps)
- Must cover both mouth and nose securely
- Cloth or disposable are acceptable
- No gaiters or scarfs are allowed
- No face shields can be used without also wearing a mask underneath







Uniform Shirts & Masks

- Students will each be given one uniform shirt and mask (if needed)
- These will be distributed on March 22nd during the student orientation


