It's Time To REOPEN!

Camptonville Families,

We have been granted permission to reopen Camptonville Elementary School to in-person instruction starting October 26th by the Yuba/Sutter Health offices. This is very exciting news for us as we have been anxious to have all of our students back to campus. The staff is working hard to prepare for our reopening and I wanted to provide you all with some information that you will need so that we can have a safe and successful start.

Health Requirements for Returning to Campus:

- Daily, students will be health screened when arriving at school. At the drop off circle, every student must have their temperature checked and be below 100.4*.
 Students will have their hand stamped when they are clear to enter.
- Everyone (students, staff and visitors) is required to wear a mask while on campus. Masks may be removed for eating. A face shield may be worn for students in K-2 instead of a mask.
- Students should bring a labeled, full water bottle to school daily as the drinking fountains will not be in service.
- Students will be receiving daily reminders and training for hand washing and sanitizing. We have hand sanitizer for all of the classrooms, but could always use more. If you would like to donate some to the school, you can bring it to the office at any time.
- All visitors must complete a health screening and temperature check when arriving on campus. Visitors may only go to the main office. If you need to pick up your child early, please call ahead and we can have them ready for you.
 If you are dropping off something for your child, please do so at the office and we will deliver it to them.
- There will be no bus service available at this time.

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, they must quarantine for 10 days from the time of the positive test. Any student or staff member who has been in close contact with a known case of COVID-19 will be notified and instructed to quarantine for 14 days.

If a student has any symptoms listed below, the student must stay home for 48 hours after the symptom(s) have subsided including fever (without the use of fever reducing medications.)

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatique
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose (not allergy related)
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

It is important to remember that one student contracting Covid-19 can shut our school down for an extended period. It is best to be overly cautious and remain home if you are not feeling well.

Your teachers will be sending out more information to you via google classroom or emails for any classroom specific details they will have, so please check those regularly. Below you will find the daily schedule, we look forward to seeing you all on October 26th!
