6. The number 110 is on a house whose color name has 2 vowels in it.





5. The instrument Tiara plays has 2 syllables.





6. The chickadee did not land 3rd or 4th.





6. Grandma saw the person who gave Molly the puppy charm at the mall this morning.





6. The family went walking on a day earlier in the week than they went biking.





5. Valerie and the camper from New Hampshire have the same color eyes.





5. The mushrooms were not paired with something green.




