All K-5 students are taught through face-to-face instruction utilizing the MBF Child Safety Matters

All K-5 students are taught through face to face instruction utilizing the IMB Child Safety Matters Curriculum by the certified classroom teacher and certified school clinical social worker.

Students in grade 6-8 were instructed utilizing the online/computer based Purpose Prep curriculum and facilitated by a certified teacher during their PE course. Due to school closure, as a result of COVID-19, the district attempted to continue the online curriculum instruction with students who had access to appropriate technology at home.

Students in grade 9 were instructed utilizing the online/computer based Purpose Prep curriculum and facilitated by a certified teacher during their required HOPE PE course as it relates to standards taught within this course. Due to school closure, as a result of COVID-19, the district attempted to continue the online curriculum instruction with students who had access to appropriate technology at home.

Students in grade 10 were instructed utilizing the online/computer based Purpose Prep curriculum and facilitated by a certified teacher during their required World History Course. Teachers utilize part of a class period weekly to facilitate this online course with students. Due to school closure, as a result of COVID-19, the district attempted to continue the online curriculum instruction with students who had access to appropriate technology at home.

Students in grade 11 were instructed utilizing the online/computer based Purpose Prep curriculum and facilitated by a certified teacher during their required English III course. Teachers part of a class period weekly to facilitate this online course with students. Due to school closure as a result of COVID-19 the district attempted to continue the online curriculum instruction with students who had access to appropriate technology at home.

The Liberty County School District chose to partner with an online internet based comprehensive Mental Health and Substance use/abuse program through Edgenuity in cooperation with Purpose Prep.

This curriculum meets the ruling requirement of instruction for youth mental and emotional health which advances each year with developmentally appropriate instruction and skill building and addresses topics a-j. It is computer based learning facilitated by a certified teacher with support, as needed, from available mental health professionals. Each student was assigned to receive content via their own computer device with facilitation/support provided by a certified teacher.

6th Grade: All 6th graders are required to take PE (student's current PE course exceeds mandatory number of minutes therefore there is sufficient time to have pull out sessions to implement this curriculum with students without losing required minutes for PE); groups of students were taken, on a rotation basis, to a classroom setting where the teacher facilitated the implementation of the online curriculum. As a result of school closure due to COVID-19, the district attempted to continue this instruction via distance learning for students who had access to the technology needed to engage in the curriculum.

7th Grade: All 7th graders are required to take PE (student's current PE course exceeds mandatory number of minutes therefore there is sufficient time to have pull out sessions to implement this curriculum with students without losing required minutes for PE); groups of students were taken, on a rotation basis, to a classroom setting where the teacher facilitated the implementation of the online curriculum. As a result of school closure due to COVID-19, the district attempted to continue this instruction via distance learning for students who had access to the technology needed to engage in the curriculum.

10th: All 10th graders are required to take the World History course. Curriculum was taught during a class period each week with online curriculum being facilitated by the certified

classroom teacher. As a result of school closure due to COVID-19, the district attempted to continue this instruction via distance learning for students who had access to the technology needed to engage in the curriculum.

11th: All 11th graders are required to take English III. Curriculum was taught during a class period each week with online curriculum being facilitated by the certified classroom teacher. As a result of school closure due to COVID-19, the district attempted to continue this instruction via distance learning for students who had access to the technology needed to engage in the curriculum.

12th: All 12th graders are required to take English IV. Curriculum was taught during a class period each week with online curriculum being facilitated by the certified classroom teacher. As a result of school closure due to COVID-19, the district attempted to continue this instruction via distance learning for students who had access to the technology needed to engage in the curriculum.
