

## KENTUCKY PARAEDUCATOR ASSESSMENT

Paraeducators whose duties include instructional support and who work in a program supported with Title 1-A funds must meet one of the following:

1. Completed two years of study at an institution of higher education; **or**
2. Obtained an associate's (or higher) degree; **or**
3. Received a passing score on the *Kentucky Paraeducator Assessment*.

1. Obtain a copy of the *Kentucky Paraeducator Assessment (KPA) Study Guide and Math Review Packet* from the Christian County Board of Education.
2. You should plan on spending at least **six hours** reading and reviewing the *KPA Study Guide* and **six hours** studying the *Math Review Packet*. After reviewing both study guides, if you feel you could use additional instruction, please feel free to contact HCC Adult Education, (707-3925) to schedule a time to come to the center.
3. **Prior to taking the KPA, all individuals are required to take the math section of the TABE test.** This test takes approximately 1 ¼ hours and may be taken on the same day as the KPA or on a day prior to the KPA. Contact HCC Adult Education (707-3925) to set up an appointment to take the TABE and KPA. The KPA assessment is not timed, but usually takes approximately 1 ½ hours to complete.
4. If you do not pass the KPA, you may receive additional instruction from Adult Education and then re-test.
