

Franklin County Virtual Learning Contract

The Franklin County School District will offer a virtual learning plan beginning August 5th, 2020. This plan will allow the student to remain enrolled in Franklin County Schools, access technology that is available to all students in the district, complete coursework that is aligned to Tennessee State Standards free of charge, receive grades, and check out chromebooks and hot spots free of charge if needed.

1. Students must be registered to participate in remote learning by July 21st, 2020. After this date, admission to the program will require approval from the director of schools.
2. All digital resources are accessed through each student's Clever account.
3. Course assignments will coordinate with the student's assigned courses in Skyward.
4. A virtual learning coordinator will monitor student use and performance on these programs and will make any needed adjustments to individual student learning plans.
5. Students will be required to participate via an online platform (Zoom, Google hangout, etc).
6. Grades will be given based on student performance on the lessons and assessments in these technology-based programs. Grades will be posted in Skyward.
7. Technical support, tutoring support, and general program support will be provided and can be requested via links on the Clever platform or resource page.
8. Students will complete a Digital Citizenship program appropriate for their age level prior to beginning coursework.
9. Parents and/or legal guardians will complete a technology access survey and sign a contract agreeing to the parameters of the program as well as a chromebook agreement to accept financial responsibility for the assigned device.
10. Students must remain in the virtual learning cohort until the end of the grading period. At that point, parents will be given the opportunity to place their student in the regular school setting.
11. Attendance requirements must be met daily (4 hours Kindergarten, 6.5 hours grades 1-12)
12. Students who are registered for virtual learning will still be eligible for meal pick-ups.
