2. Communications

2.1. Principal's Report/Student Achievement

Rationale:

Principal Robin Kelsch informed board members of successful summer programs with the Augusta Art Guild sponsorship of five students' participation in the Maysville Players Drama Camp and Literacy "Critter" Camp at AIS.

The Youth Employment Program has employed approximately 20 area youth ages 17-24 years old at various businesses and AIS this summer, according to Principal Kelsch.

Principal Kelsch updated the board of a Re-Entry Plan for a student expelled during 2017-2018 school year who will re-enter during the 2019-2020 school year.

2.2. Superintendent's Report

Rationale:

Superintendent Lisa McCane reported the Global GVBACK Project to Circle H, Inc. bridled success and raised \$2,000 to send 12 students to horse camp July 29th-August 2nd.

Summer Adventures in Reading Program supported by the Dollar General Literacy Grant will use FastForword, a program hailed in brain research during a four week reading program, according to Superintendent McCane. She stated the program will target 1st-4th graders and provide 2.5 hours of intensive reading instruction daily for students with reading scores in the bottom quartile. Superintendent McCane informed the board district officials were meeting with representatives from the GEAR UP Kentucky Program about the possibility of district participation starting during the 2019-2020 school year. The GEAR UP Kentucky Program is a state grant designed to increase the college and technical career program attendance rate of at risk students in low income communities, according to Superintendent McCane. She stated this would bring needed resources, programs and personnel to the district for the middle and high school levels.

3.1. Approve Monthly Budget Report

Rationale:

May 2019 Budget Report

General Fund

Revenue receipts through May totaled nearly \$1,817,000.

Local Revenue: Year-to-date, \$278,000 was received in property taxes. \$115,000 was received in utility taxes. \$27,000 has been collected in motor vehicle taxes. \$27,000 was collected in tuition, while \$21,000 has been received in PSC taxes. \$6,400 was received for transportation reimbursement. \$3,400 was received for delinquent property taxes, while \$3,000 was received for refunds of

prior year expenditures. More than \$2,200 has been collected for the fitness center. \$1,800 was received in donations.

State Revenue: Approximately \$1,310,000 was received in SEEK funding, while \$5,900 was received for revenue in lieu of taxes from the state.

Federal Revenue: \$8,000 was received for Medicaid reimbursement.

Expenditures through May totaled nearly \$1,622,000.

School Budget: The school's budget is \$20,006. Through May, \$18,700 was expended, with another \$600 obligated. Expenses included \$6,300 on copying and printing costs, \$3,900 on supplemental curriculum materials, \$3,600 on general supplies, \$1,500 for assessment materials, \$1,200 on technology fees/supplies, \$1,000 dues and fees, and \$400 on postage.

Maintenance Budget: Expenses totaled approximately \$226,000 through May. Expenses included \$77,000 on salaries and benefits, \$76,000 on utility services, \$33,000 for property insurance, \$13,500 on repairs and maintenance, \$15,000 on general supplies, \$6,300 for machinery/equipment, and \$5,700 on professional services/snow removal/fees. 78% of the maintenance budget has been utilized. Transportation Budget: Through May, costs totaled \$64,700, including \$29,700 on salaries and benefits, \$11,000 on diesel fuel, \$6,000 on fleet insurance, \$6,000 on vehicles, \$4,400 on repair parts, \$4,000 on vehicle repair, and \$2,000 on professional services/supplies/fees. 52% of the transportation budget has been utilized.

For the general fund, receipts exceeded expenditures by \$195,500.

Special Revenue Fund Nothing to report

Food Service Fund

Food service receipts through May totaled \$176,000. \$158,600 was received in federal reimbursement, \$15,000 was collected in local revenue, and \$1,700 from state revenue. Expenses totaled \$137,000 including \$85,400 for food and supplies, \$43,000 for salaries and benefits, \$5,200 on equipment/machinery, \$1,400 on equipment repair/printing costs, and \$1,200 for dues and fees. The food service balance as of May 31 was nearly \$51,500.
