6. Covid protocols and procedures
  - i. We have followed the HCBE Reopening Plan and HCBE Covid-19 Protocols
    1. We function as closed cohorts. We also have cohorts in a cohort.
7. School Improvement Visit---shared the following data
  - i. PK-Students are moving through the WSO checklist items at a regular pace
  - ii. Kindergarten-GKIDS data shows 70%+ know some upper and lower case letters, 79+ count 10+ objects using one to one correspondence
  - iii. 1st grade-ELA---18% low achievement, 64% low to high average, 18% high Math--11% low achievement, 72% low to high average, 17% high (greatest discrepancy is in common core math standards: numbers and operations/algebra)
  - iv. 2nd grade-ELA---23% low achievement, 47% low to high average, 30 % high Math--20% low achievement, 57% low to high average, 23% high
  - v. What does this mean? During the Pandemic Crisis Teaching parents were able to continue with basic skills (letters, numbers, reading, measurement, geometry, and writing). Common Core math and math skills were more difficult to teach. During Pandemic Full Instruction 1st 9 weeks, we have been able to close some gaps, serve smaller teacher/student ratios and evaluate gaps.
8. Over 60 students returned to in person instruction from Houston Virtual. We now have 1-K, 1 ½ 1<sup>st</sup> grade, and 1 ½ 2<sup>nd</sup> grade classes in Houston Virtual (Mrs. Hall teaches one segment of 1<sup>st</sup> and one segment of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.)
9. PTO is keeping us motivated and focused on school spirit and fundraising for our new post Covid-19 playground additions.
10. Spirit Day Initiative---Zooms to in-person and Houston Virtual to raise school spirit and morale We have celebrated Spirit days, the Popcorn Fundraiser, enjoyed the Sunset Slush Mobile Truck,

birthday treats, and the Boo Buckets, and the Sunshine Cart. We continue to celebrate milestones like the 50<sup>th</sup> day, teacher spotlights, and Character Education.

11. **Morale initiatives---PAWS REBOOT 2020-morale and teacher support**
12. **PBIS-Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports has started at LJPS. This is an evidence-base three-tiered framework to improve and integrate all of the data, systes, and practices affecting student outcomes every day, to create student success.**

14. **MAP was given to in person, iReady was given to distance learners, and MAP is currently being administered to students who returned to in-person. This data is being used to develop differentiation plans of instruction for all students.**
