Special Board of Education Meeting  
May 25, 2021

The special meeting of the Tawas Area Board of Education was called to order by President Klenow at 5:02 p.m. on Tuesday, May 25, 2021 in the boardroom at the administration office and through Google Meets or a teleconferencing method.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS – INFORMATION AND PROPOSALS**

Mrs. Klenow asked if there were any public comments on agenda or non-agenda items. There were no comments.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Klinger said a resolution must be read regarding IRESA's biennial election. This year's election will take place on Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, at 4:00 p.m. A district must designate its representative for the electoral body and an alternate member must also be selected in the event the designated member is unable to attend. The board also needs to name the individual(s) that they want the representative to vote for on their behalf. This year there are three vacancies that need to be filled and three candidates running. Mrs. Edmonds said she would represent the board at the election and Mr. Butzin agreed to be the alternate. Mrs. Edmonds was directed to cast a vote on the first ballot on behalf of the board for Gary L. Gillings for a 6-year term, Mike McCarley for a 6-year term and Tana L. McKulsky for the 4-year term. Mrs. Bruning made a motion to approve the Resolution Designating the District's Election Representative (Mrs. Edmonds and Mr. Butzin as alternate) for the June 7<sup>th</sup> biennial IRESA election, and to direct Mrs. Edmonds to cast the vote on the first ballot for Gary L. Gillings for a 6-year term, Mike McCarley for a 6-year term and Tana L. McKulsky for the 2-year term, as discussed. Motion supported by VanderVeen. Motion carried unanimously.
