## 5. Report of Principal

Covid 19

- County Reopening plan
- Drive-By Meet and Greet -Good experience!
- BES Specific
  - o Adults/children will wear masks in transition
  - o Each adult will be provided 2 masks from the county
  - o BES
  - Outside:
    - Coach is chalking 6 feet markings on the walkways around the building
  - Front office:
    - No visitors past the front office
    - Sneeze guards
    - 3 at a time
    - New buzz in system
  - Hallways:
    - Arrival 7:45-straight to classroom

- Grab and go Breakfast
- Xs 6 feet apart
- Trashcans and social distancing signs
- Students from bus entering different locations
- Students wear masks in transition
- Water Fountains are turned off (we have extra water)
- Cafeteria:
  - Grab and Go lunch-eat in classrooms
  - Xs in the cafeteria where students stand
  - Lunch monitors will move trashcans to classrooms
  - Lanyards for lunch line students (scan barcode)
- o Bathroom:
  - Lines where students can stand a wait
- o Specials (music, art, PE)
  - Only 1 class for the team per week (ex: Mrs. Abbott's class will only go to PE all week and then will have music all the following week).
  - Cleaning after each class
  - No community supplies
  - No signing in music at the start
- Media Center:
  - Class trips to the media center
  - Books will sit for 24 hours and be wiped down
  - Class times assigned for individual check out to occur for that class
  - Sneeze guards at the tables
- Computer labs
  - Sneeze guards between the computers
  - Assigned times
  - Sanitation before and afterwards
- o Classrooms:
  - Desks at least 3 feet a part
  - Seating Charts
  - Removed furniture to support social distancing
  - Foggers bought for each team (on the way!)
  - Thermometers bought for each team
  - Handwashing schedules
  - No communal supplies
  - Students not required to wear a mask if 3 feet apart, but can.
- Recess
  - Individual class locations
  - Wear a mask in transition
  - Lanyard to place mask while playing
  - Handwashing when returning to the classroom
- Dismissal:
  - Dismissing fewer students at a time to car rider
  - Only loading 1 bus at a time
  - Media Center-walk up pick up will only enter 6 names at a time.
- o Testing
  - Wavier
  - MAP first 4 weeks
