This is to advise you that the tuition rates for various grade levels within the district have been computed for the 2012-13 school year. The rates are listed below for your information.

A factor that influences these rates is the student enrollment at the various levels and changes in the same. If fixed costs are remaining constant but enrollment is decreasing, the result typically is an increase in tuition rates. It should be pointed out that the debt service cost, although not included in the operating budget of the school, is incorporated in these costs from the Town Budget. A portion of the debt service is reimbursed to the Town via building grants. That number was reduced by \$216,725 in these calculations.

Also, it is important to note that these are the rates that are used for regular education students. As stated above, Special Education costs are excluded from these calculations as are transportation costs. Should it become necessary to bill out for a special education student, it would be done on a case by case basis using specific program cost plus ancillary services as may be required by the Individual Education Plan for the student.

I will gladly be available to answer any questions regarding this calculation.
