**Subject: Cafeteria Charges** 

The Newport City School Food Service is designed to be pre-pay or "pay as you eat."

Three types of meals are authorized: free, reduced and paid. There is no legal recognition of a charged meal by federal auditors. Each student will receive a copy of the cafeteria policy at the beginning of school. Any new or transfer student will also receive a copy of the charge policy. In order to comply with regulations, the Board of Education established the following policy to govern all meal purchases by students and adult employees.

- 1. Only a complete breakfast or lunch may be charged by students.
- 2. Students with outstanding charges will not be allowed to purchase a la carte' items.
- 3. Adult employees of the school system may charge meals or a la carte' items.
- 4. When a charge occurs, the student or adult employee will be alerted by the cashier that payment is needed. Payments may be made using My Payments Plus, cash, or check.
- 5. Once a week charge notices requesting payment will be sent to students and adult employees.
- 6. When students pass charging 5 lunch meals, a phone call by the Cafeteria Manager will be made. If no payment is made within the second week after a call or contact, the meal charges will be considered delinquent debt.
- 7. If payment is not made after 10 days, a list of outstanding charges will be sent to the principal. The principal will contact parents or personnel for outstanding charges.
- 8. Administration will collect any charges from employees who may owe at the end of the school year.
- 9. General Purpose (not cafeteria fund) shall be responsible for any bad debts that are outstanding at the close of the school year.
