The implementation of a unified media program throughout the Webster County School System shall be based on procedures implemented by the Superintendent in accordance with State Board of Education rules and regulations.

The procedures implemented by the Superintendent shall contain provisions to ensure that:

- 1) A media committee is established at the system level to be responsible for the development of media procedures for the school system, including:
 - a. Selecting media and instructional materials,
 - b. Handling requests for reconsideration of materials,
 - c. Considering gifts of instructional resources,
 - d. Using non-school owned materials, and
 - e. Complying with copyright law.
 - f. Provide input into various aspects of the media center operation, including:
 - i. Making recommendations and decisions related to planning, operation, evaluation and improvement of the media program;

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- ii. Annually evaluating media services; and
- iii. Developing a multi-year media plan for budget and services priorities.
